The Space

The Community Stage is centrally located just north of the Activity Center, providing an accessible and lively atmosphere that will draw in fairgoers throughout the day. The stage is designed to offer shade for both participants and viewers, creating a comfortable environment for everyone. A seated area is available for the audience, giving them a place to sit back, relax, and enjoy the performances. This dedicated space is ideal for showcasing your talents in a supportive, family-friendly setting that celebrates our local community.

Equipment

The stage is equipped with a portable sound system, including speakers and one (1) microphone, to ensure your performance reaches every corner of the audience. It also includes a walk-up stair entry for easy access.

Who Can Participate?

We are looking for acts that involve local talent – aka anyone within Jefferson County. Performers should have a history of performing anywhere.

Acts include, but are not limited to: jugglers, comedians, cloggers, gymnasts, puppeteers, hula hoopers, rock bands, scarf dancers, mimes, magicians, story tellers, beatboxers, improv troupes, and much more!

Your Performance

Each group selected to perform will have one hour of stage time. This includes time for setup, performance, and takedown, so we recommend preparing accordingly to maximize your stage time. We encourage performers to bring any additional equipment or props needed to personalize the act.
