Please note there have been a few changes made:

- There will be **no** Open Class exhibits this year. This was done so that 4-H Static projects could spread out for social distancing. 4-H static projects will be housed in the Green building along with utilizing the Open Class building.
- There will not be a dog show this year due to training being cut short this spring and the cancelation of the Kansas State Fair Dog Show.
- Rabbits will be absent at the Johnson County Fair due to a disease RHDV2 that has shown up in Kansas.

Now for some great news-

The livestock shows and events will take place just as you have known them with one exception... The wording '4-H' will be absent. In order for the Fair Board to bring you traditional livestock shows as we have known them, this was a necessary change.

The 2020 Johnson County Fair Livestock Shows will take place as a Johnson County youth open show. This will be open to Johnson County 4-H/FFA members only (youth ages 7-18 years old). Exhibitors will enter Livestock exhibits as they have historically in the 4-H division of ShoWorks. Please note classes and schedules will be followed as listed in the fair book.
