Clay Walker Headlining the Josephine County Fair

Josephine County, Oregon. The Josephine County Fair Board is pleased to announce that legendary Country Artist **Clay Walker** will headline the Josephine County Fair on Thursday, July 30, 2026, in the Grandstands!

Clay Walker stands as a towering figure in country music, his illustrious career marked by multi-PLATINUM sales, 11 chart-topping hits and 40 singles on the charts. His songs, including classics like "If I Could Make A Living" and "She Won't Be Lonely Long," resonate deeply, etching his name into the fabric of the genre. In 1996, Walker faced a new battle with Multiple Sclerosis (MS), but rather than yielding to its challenges, he emerged as a fierce advocate and fundraiser, establishing the Clay Walker Foundation to support those affected by the disease. The foundation hosts events including the Clay Walker Charity Classic at Pebble Beach and Band Against MS Gala, raising awareness and funds for MS research. His single, *Texas To Tennessee* soared to No. 1 on the iTunes Country Albums chart, drawing inspiration from legends including George Jones, James Taylor and Bob Seger. Last Fall, he headlined Ryman Auditorium for the first time in his career, performing to a sold-out crowd in Nashville and will play major festivals in 2026 including Tortuga, Boots in the Park, Two Step Inn and more. A member of the Texas Cowboy Hall of Fame, Walker continues to captivate audiences nationwide, gracing stages from coast to coast with his electrifying performances, showcasing his unwavering passion for music and advocacy.
