GENERAL RULES FOR NON-LIVESTOCK EXHIBITS

- 1. All articles entered must be the work of the Exhibitor and have not been previously Exhibited in a prior year at the Josephine County Fair.
- 2. Online entries must be submitted by the date stated and published within each Department's Rules. Information must be accurate and complete.
- 3. Entries must be delivered and removed only during the published scheduled times. Removal of an Exhibit before the designated time forfeits all awards for that Exhibit. Items not picked up within 10 days after the close of Fair are forfeited by the Exhibitor unless otherwise stated in the competitions' rules.
- 4. Entries will receive a claim check upon delivery of their item(s) and must present the claim check in order to pick up items at the scheduled pick-up time after Fair.
- 5. Superintendent or Judge may disqualify or transfer any Exhibit to a more suitable Class which, in their opinion, is not a true representation of the Class in which it is entered or if published rules are not followed.
- 6. Departments are closed to the Public while Exhibits are being judged. Ribbons and/or prizes will be as warranted. All Judge's results are final.
- 7. Exhibitors found in violation of rules, or to be in practices unethical or adverse to Josephine County Fair, shall be penalized by forfeiture of awards and/or privileges and removed from the Exhibit.
- 8. The Josephine County Fair Board will take reasonable precautions to ensure the safety of Exhibits while at the Fairgrounds, but will not be responsible for loss, damage, theft or injury of any kind to Exhibits or Exhibitors. Exhibitors shall indemnify and hold harmless Josephine County which shall include all authorities, boards, bureaus, commissions, divisions, departments, districts and offices of Josephine County and the individual members, employees and agents thereof in their official capacities.
- 9. Media Disclaimer: Josephine County Fair reserves the right to use any photo or video taken at any event without the expressed written permission of those included within the photo or video. Josephine County Fair may use the photo or video in publications or other media. To ensure the privacy of an individual, images will not be identified using names or personal identifying information without written approval from the photographed Subject, Parent or Legal Guardian. Any person not affiliated with Josephine County Fair may not use, copy, alter or modify official Josephine County Fair photos, graphics, videography or other similar reproductions or recordings without the advance written consent of an authorized designee from Josephine County Fair.

COMPETITION RULES

Pavilion Building

- 1. All General Rules apply. Your submission indicates you have read and agree to abide by the General Rules and the Competition Rules.
- 2. Entry deadline is August 1, 2024, AT 11:59pm.
- 3. Entries must be registered online at https://josephine.fairwire.com/ before drop-off/submittal.
- 4. Only amateur Exhibitors may enter Baked Food divisions.
- 5. No entry fee is required. Each Exhibitor is limited to one Entry per Class except in the Juniors and Teens Divisions. Juniors and Teens may enter up to three Entries in each Class in Divisions 1109 and 1110. All Exhibitors are limited to a maximum of 20 Entries total.
- 6. Entries will be accepted on Friday, August 2, 2024, noon-7:00 PM, and Saturday, August 3, 2024, 9:00 AM 3:00 PM, in the Pavilion Building.
- 7. Entries in the Juniors Divisions are encouraged to have adult supervision while baking.
- 8. The "OTHER (Specify)" Class is to be used only when an item does not fit the description of any other Class in the division.
- 9. All Entries must be home-prepared by the Exhibitor. Entries must be from scratch and must not contain packaged mixes. Packaged crackers are acceptable.
- 10. All Entries must be delivered individually on a disposable plate/board, covered with plastic wrap or aluminum foil or in a box. No Entry will be accepted uncovered.
- 11. Entries in some Classes may require a recipe on a 4 x6 card. Refer to specific Class rules and requirements.
- 12. Pies must be baked in an aluminum (non-returnable) pan. For a good bottom pie crust, place aluminum pie pan on an old dark cookie sheet or old iron skillet when baking.
- 13. Limited refrigeration is available (i.e. for Cheesecakes, etc.) and will be provided at the discretion of the Department Superintendent.
- 14. Entries may be disqualified by the Judge if rules are not followed. The Exhibitor must follow additional rules/instructions described for specific division. Decisions by the Judge are final.
- 15. All baked foods will be disposed of at the end of Fair.
- 16. Entries will be judged using the American Judging System.

NOTE: Division 1109 is for Juniors (Ages 6-12) and Division 1110 is for Teens (Ages 13-17). Juniors & Teens may also enter in the Adult Divisions and will be judged with all Entries in the Class. Divisions 1111 - 1122 are for Adults (Ages 18+). Division 1123 is for all ages.

*ALTERNATE DIETARY NEEDS TIPS

- Entries must include full recipe on a 3x5 or 4x6 card.
- Product may be entered in only one Class (i.e. product or same recipe cannot be entered in both "Gluten Free" and "Paleo").
- "Paleo" means the products may contain fruits, vegetables, lean meats, seafood, nuts and seeds, healthy oils such as olive, coconut, avocado, meat and nut oil excluding peanut oil. They should not contain dairy, grains, processed food and refined sugar, legumes, starches and alcohol.
- Vegetarian/Vegan means that these products will be described in the following manner: "Lacto-ovo vegetarian" should not include meat, but may contain dairy products (milk, butter, cheese) and eggs. "Ovo-vegetarian" can contain eggs, but no meat or dairy products. "Vegan" should contain no meat or animal products.
