Sept 20	Entries are released at 6:00 pm – 8:00 pm **No early releases
Sept. 21	Entries released between 9:00 am – 1:00 pm
After Sept 20	You must contact KSF Admin Office to arrange to pick up (620) 669- 3621 or (620) 669-3600. All items should be picked up within 1 week from the closing of the Fair (by Sept. 24 th). After that date, limited pick-up times will be available.
October 1	All remaining Exhibits will be discarded.

- All teacher-entered school artwork will be displayed in the Oz Gallery.
- Due to limited display space, **each student will only be allowed one entry** in their division.
- Student Art has no fee to enter.
- Homeschool students are allowed to enter School Art.
- If the student wishes to enter additional artwork, they may do so individually in the Fine Arts Department.
- Entry fee for Open Class is \$1.00 per item and \$1.00 per Exhibitor.
- School Artwork will not be released to individual parents. Educators are to pick up their entries.

All exhibits/artwork must have a label on the back of the sheet with the student's full name, school name, teacher name, and grade level. NO EXCEPTIONS - Artwork will not be accepted without this information.

Division 1 – Pre-K – Kindergarten School Art

- All artwork is to be on **9" x 12"** paper. Should any item exceed the size imitation, it will not be accepted.
- No mounting is necessary. No frames.
- If an entry is accepted by oversight, it may later be disqualified and/or not judged or displayed.
- Drawing/paintings only. Do not glue objects to paper. No beans, No pasta, No yarn, Etc.
- All craft items may be entered in Open Class, Division 1 – 4 at a cost of \$1.00.
- Disability students may use a preprinted coloring page.
- Must have student's full name, school name, teacher name, and grade level. No exceptions – Artwork will not be accepted without this information.
- Follo the theme.

Division 2 – School Art - 1st –2rd Grade

- All artwork is to be on **9" x 12"** paper. Should any item exceed the size imitation, it will not be accepted.
- No mounting is necessary. No frames.
- If an entry is accepted by oversight, it may later be disqualified and/or not judged or displayed.
- Drawing/paintings only. Do not glue objects to paper. No beans, No pasta, No yarn, Etc.
- All craft items may be entered in Open Class, Division 1 – 4 at a cost of \$1.00.
- Disability students may use a preprinted coloring page.
- Must have student's full name, school name, teacher name, and grade level. No exceptions –

- Drawing/paintings only. Do not glue objects to paper. No beans, No pasta, No yarn, Etc.
- All craft items may be entered in Open Class, Division 1 – 4 at a cost of \$1.00.
- Disability students may use a preprinted coloring page.
- Must have student’s full name, school name, teacher name, and grade level. No exceptions – Artwork will not be accepted without this information.

- Drawing/paintings only. Do not glue objects to paper. No beans, No pasta, No yarn, Etc.
- All craft items may be entered in Open Class, Division 1 – 4 at a cost of \$1.00.

Division 5 – School Art- 7th – 8th Grades

No theme for Division 6 – Be creative!

- Stretched Canvas may be used. Edges must be finished – no raw edges.
- Canvas Boards may be framed. ONLY LIGHT-WEIGHT FRAMES.
- Not to exceed 40"
- Must have wire or eyes for hanging. Do not use nailed-on hangers or masking tape.
- Entries may be matted within a frame.
- Frames are allowed in Division 6 ONLY

Classes:

01 - Any student with a disability. May use preprinted coloring page.

02 - Choice of Media – Crayon, paint, marker, pastel, mixed media. No preprinted page.

WORKMANSHIP - DESIGN - GENERAL APPEARANCE

ADDITIONAL RULES/INFORMATION - READ CAREFULLY

1. **Any item that does not meet the requirements will not be accepted. If an item is accepted as an oversight, it may later be disqualified and/or not judged or displayed.**
2. **All items must have the student's name, grade level, school, and teacher on the back of the exhibit.**
3. Subject matter must be original and not copies (Except for disability students). Entries must be the

work of the exhibitor with work being done since the 2025 State Fair.

4. Artwork in frames, on stretchers, or canvas must have wire or eyes for hanging. Do not use nail-on hangers or masking tape - Division 6 only.
5. Our primary audience consists of family and youth. We reserve the right to reject any entry/exhibit which may be considered objectionable by that audience.
6. All exhibits will receive the best care and protection in their surroundings. At all times exhibits are subject to owner's risk and in no event will the Fair be responsible for any damage which may occur. All exhibits will be displayed at the discretion of the Department staff.
