## **Entries are subject to the Kansas State Fair General Information and Rules**

1. There must be more than one exhibitor in a class to pay more than one premium placing.
2. All entries are subject to the provisions and rules set forth by the Kansas State Fair for open class beef cattle. Any deviation will be grounds for immediate disqualification.
3. All cattle must be properly tattooed and readable. All entries must be accompanied with the original registration papers, or an affidavit of registration issued by the American Gelbvieh Association.
4. Gelbvieh and Balancer cattle will each compete within their respective shows. Group classes can be made up of a combination of Gelbvieh and Balancer cattle, but no group can be entirely made up of Balancers.
5. Percentage and purebred Gelbvieh females, 75% to 100%, will show together. Percentage, purebred and full blood Gelbvieh bulls, 87% to 100%, will show together. To qualify for the Balancer show all cattle must meet the American Gelbvieh Association rules for registration as a Balancer Hybrid. Females, specifically as 75% Gelbvieh female, that qualify to show in either the Gelbvieh or Balancer show, can only be entered in one show. Exhibitor must designate Gelbvieh or Balancer on the entry form. No changes will be allowed after entries are received.
6. All bulls must show with a nose lead.
7. The right to disqualify from the show any animal deemed unmanageable is reserved by show committee and Kansas State Fair management.
8. This is a no fit show, "Blow and Show". No adhesive, glue, paint or powder products.
9. No animal may be shown that has had any foreign object glued to or otherwise attached in any manner so as to alter its conformation or change its appearance.
10. Jointly owned animals must be entered and exhibited under the joint ownership in the individual classes.
11. Fans in each aisle must blow the same direction. Each aisle will blow opposite directions; direction will be designated by show officials. NO free standing, aisle fans or portable coolers are allowed.
12. Note: All females shown in cow/calf class with a calf over 150 days of age must be bred back and must be accompanied by a verification of pregnancy signed by a licensed veterinarian. Exception to the rule of safe in calf will apply to a donor female that has produced eggs in the previous 12 months as verification with a written statement from a licensed veterinarian; Show management will be responsible for checking the health papers. Age of calf at side in cow/calf class must not exceed 240 days as of date of show.
