2021 Education Poster Contest



Help with myth-busting by informing consumers about the important cattle products we use on a daily basis. Create a poster with at least 15 by-products that come from cattle besides beef and milk.



Requirements:

- · One entry per exhibitor. All work must be that of the exhibitor.
- Poster needs to be on a 30" x 20," White Foam Board (Dollar Tree, Walmart)
- Using an outline of a steer/cow, display actual products/packaging from cattle byproducts inside the outline. Make sure the products are secure - the poster will be displayed for the entire 10 days of the Fair.
- Poster is titled: "Cattle By-Products."
- · All words can be handwritten.
- Must include a minimum of 15 by-products (Grades 2-5) and 20 by-products (Grades 6-12).
- Grades 6-12 must also list where the shown by-product came from:

i.e. Hooves/Horns Blood Hair/Skin
emery boards medicines leather
plastics ink/dye drumheads

- Leave a 3" x 3" space in lower left corner for entry tag.
- · Name, School, Grade, County and Phone Number listed on back.

- · All entries must be pre-registered online with the Kansas State Fair by Aug 26, 2021.
- Exhibits will only be accepted at the OZ Building during the Kansas State Fair scheduled receiving times, Friday, August 27, 10 am 5 pm., and Saturday, August 28, 10 am -2 pm.
- Judged on appearance, creativity and content.
- · All posters will be displayed in the Oz Building for the duration of the Fair.

Four Judging Classes Offered by Kansas State Fair Education Dept.
