Saturday, September 4, 2021 – Market Lamb Show

Rules of the Show

Classes: Dorper, Southdown, Finewool, Finewool-Cross, Medium Wool

****All lambs must meet current Texas Animal Health Commission Regulations. ****

1. Entry Fee: \$25 per lamb.
2. Must furnish own wood shavings
3. No weight limit. No limit on number of entries.
4. Classes will be split by weight by the committee.
5. All lambs must carry all baby teeth and must be slick shorn.
6. All Ewe lambs must have scrapies Premise Tag in their ear.
7. Weigh backs will be done during the show when needed.

Saturday, September 4, 2021 - Meat Goat Show

Rules of the Show

****All goats must meet current Texas Animal Health Commission Regulations.****

1. Entry Fee: \$25 per goat
2. No hay in the Barn.
3. Must furnish your own wood shavings
4. No weight limit.
5. No limit on number of entries
6. Goats must be uniformly shorn 3/8" or less above the knee and hocks.
7. Does or wethers may show. No bucks allowed to show.
8. Weigh backs will be done during the show when needed.

Rules of the Show

**** All cattle must meet current Texas Animal Health Commission Regulations.**

1. Entry Fee: \$20 per Heifer
2. No hay in the Barn.
3. **Arrival time: 4pm Saturday, September 4th**
4. **Turn in age/breed paperwork by 5pm**
5. Showtime 10am, Sunday, September 1st
6. Must furnish own wood shavings
7. Classes will be split by weight by the livestock committee
8. All empty trailers must park in the **designated area in an orderly fashion!** All trailers NOT parked in the designated area **WILL BE TOWED AT THE OWNERS EXPENSE!**

Sunday, September 5, 2021 – Steer Show

Rules of the Show

** All cattle must meet current Texas Animal Health Commission Regulations.

1. Entry Fee: \$25 per Heifer
2. **Arrival time: Must be on the grounds by 4pm Saturday, September 4th**
3. **Class your own: Official weigh in at 5pm**
4. Showtime 10am, Sunday, September 5th
5. There will be weight divisions. A minimum of 5 head to make a breed class. If there are not 5 head per breed, they will be put in appropriate classes of British, American, or European.
6. Steers must be sufficiently halter broke to be handled safely.
7. No hay in the barn
8. Must furnish own wood shavings
9. Stalling space is limited. There will be NO PRE-ASSIGNED STALLS. Stalling will be on a first to arrive basis. When the barn is full you will have to tie to your trailers. No refund of fees!
10. Classes will be split by weight by the livestock committee
11. All empty trailers must park in the **designated area in an orderly fashion!** All trailers NOT parked in the designated area **WILL BE TOWED AT THE OWNERS EXPENSE!**

Rules of the Show

Poultry Class Definitions:

Standard Breed and Bantam Chickens

Cock: Male bird over 12 months of age

Cockrell: Male bird under 12 months of age.

Hen: Female bird over 12 months of age

Pullet: Female bird under 12 months of age

Old Pen: 1 Cock & 2 hens of same variety

Young Pen: 1 cockerel & 2 pullets of same variety

****Because of Texas laws, we can no longer provide on-site testing for Texas Pullorum-Fowl Typhoid. Poultry exhibitors should contact William Glass at (512) 466-8235 by August ____, 2021 for testing prior to admission to the fair grounds. All poultry exhibitors are required to present test results at entry time.****

1. Must furnish own wood shaving.
2. Entry Fee: \$5 per head
3. Check in by 8:30am
4. Entry Cards turned in by 9am
5. Showtime 10am
6. Current health regulations will be followed.
7. Singles will be entered as singles. There are no pen entries this year.
8. Exhibitors are responsible for feeding and watering their animals throughout the show.
