- Entry Fee: \$30 per lamb
- 7:15am Lamb & Goats - Weigh & check in begins by the committee.
- 8:00am Lamb & Goats – Must be in line no later than 8am to weight & check in.
- Showtime 10am
- Classes: Dorper, Southdown, Fine-wool, Fine-wool Cross, Medium Wool
- Must furnish own wood shavings
- No weight limits. No limit on number of entries
- The livestock committee will split classes by breed and weight
- Lambs must carry all baby teeth.
- All lambs must be slick shorn.
- There will be a 4lb weigh back.
- All Ewe lambs must have Scrapies Premise tags in their ear.

### **Details and Rules:**

- Entry Fee: \$30 per goat
- 7:15am Lamb & Goats - Weigh & check in begins by the committee.
- 8:00am Lamb & Goats – Must be in line no later than 8am to weight & check in.
- Showtime 10am
- Classes: Light weight, Medium weight, Heavy weight
- Must furnish own wood shavings
- No hay in the barn.
- No weight limits. No limit on number of entries
- The livestock committee will split classes by weight.
- There will be a 4lb weigh back.
- Goats must be uniformly shorn 3/8” or less above the knee and hocks
- Does or wethers may be shown. No bucks allowed.

- Must furnish own wood shavings
- No hay in the barn.
- The livestock committee will be split by breed and weight
- All empty trailers must park in the **designated area in an orderly fashion!** All trailers NOT parked in the designated area **WILL BE TOWED AT THE OWNERS EXPENSE!**

### **Details and Rules:**

- Entry Fee: \$30 per steer
- **Steer Check-in prior to 4pm Saturday, September 3rd**
- **5pm – Steer paperwork due and Weigh-In by the livestock committee**
- Showtime: Sunday September 4<sup>th</sup> following the Heifer show
- Must furnish own wood shavings.
- No hay in the barn.
- The livestock committee will split cattle to the appropriate class of British, American, or European and weight.
- Steers must be sufficiently halter broke to be handled safely.
- Stalling space is limited. There will be NO PRE-ASSIGNED STALLS. Stalling will be on a first to arrive basis. When the barn is full you will have to tie to your trailers. No refund of fees!
- All empty trailers must park in the **designated area in an orderly fashion!** All trailers NOT parked in the designated area **WILL BE TOWED AT THE OWNERS EXPENSE!**

\*\*Because of new Texas laws, we can no longer provide on-site testing for Texas Pullorum-Fowl Typhoid. Poultry exhibitors should contact William Glass at (512) 466-8235 as soon as possible for testing prior to admission to the fair grounds. All poultry exhibitors are required to present test results at entry time.

### **Details and Rules:**

- Entry Fee: \$5 per head
- Check in by 8:30am
- Entry Cards turned in by 9am
- Showtime 10am
- Current health regulations will be followed.
- Singles will be entered as singles. There are no pen entries this year.
- Exhibitors are responsible for feeding and watering their animals throughout the show.

### **Poultry Class Definitions:**

- Standard Breed and Bantam Chickens
- Cock: Male bird over 12 months of age
- Cockrell: Male bird under 12 months of age
- Hen: Female bird over 12 months of age
- Pullet: Female bird under 12 months of age
