Temporary Mobile Food Vendor Fire Safety Permit Requirements

In order to obtain a temporary KCFMO fire safety permit, please send our office the following compliance items (Via Email Attachments) to be verified:

APPLICATION

A Mobile Food Vendor Permit Application for fire safety can be found on the Kendall County Website (Select Forms & Permits, the application is under Fire Marshal) and must be fill out and returned to the Kendall County Fire Marshal's Office.

FIRE SAFETY INSPECTION REPORT or PERMIT TAG

Show proof of a current fire safety inspection from another agency. (San Antonio, Bexar County, Austin, Kerrville, Round Rock, etc.)

FIRE EXTINGUISHERS

- Every mobile food vendor must have an ABC fire extinguisher and if cooking food items that produce grease laden vapors (Fries, hamburgers, fajitas, etc.), a hood suppression system and a "K" type extinguisher.
- All fire extinguisher inspection tags must be up to date (show photos).

TYPE 1 HOOD SUPPRESSION SYSTEM

Show proof of the hood suppression system inspection is up to date within last 6 months.

PERMIT FEE

The permit fee is \$40.00 and payable by cash or check to "Kendall County Fire Marshal" can be dropped off or mailed to the address above. If payment by card is requested, that will need to be completed via card reader at our office. Permits are valid for four days. Application and photos can be sent to:
