## 2. Membership on Teams

- a. Team members must be Kern County Residents and should have a strong desire to serve the entire livestock program as well as their species.
- b. Individuals apply to be on Teams are chosen by the Livestock Supervisor and these individuals are presented to the Livestock Committee Chairman, Fair CEO and the Deputy Manager for approval.
- c. Team members will be required to wear Fair approved identification during the Kern County Fair.

## 3. Duties of Team Members

- a. Each Team Member must attend 2 of the 3 meetings- (March, Kick Off Dinner, Sunday After Fair Meeting)
- b. Each Member will select their job duties during the application process:
  - 1. Show Assistant-will be responsible to complete their 6 shifts.
  - 2. Sponsorships/Community Liaison-responsible to get all specie sponsorships and attend all liaison meetings and community outreach.
- c. \*If they chose Beef, Sheep, Swine or Meat Goat they must work one Livestock Show Weekend- Pacific Coast, Harvest Moon or Holiday Classic
- d. If you are a species chair you must be present for all events that pertain to your species at the fair and livestock shows.
- 4. Team Chairperson- assigned by the Livestock Superintendent
- 5. Term of Membership- Members serve from January to December of each year.
- 6. Team Size- will vary between 5-10 Members, maximum size of a team is 10 members.
