



## **Enumclaw Expo Center RV Campground Standards**

### **RV and Vehicle Condition:**

- RVs more than 20-years old must obtain pre-approval to make a reservation. Pictures will be required to assess for approval.
- RVs and vehicles must be clean and in good repair.
- RVs and vehicles with missing parts, broken windows, or repaired with plastic, tape, lumber, or cardboard are not permitted.
- Working on RVs or vehicles in the campground is prohibited without pre-approval from Camp Host or the Enumclaw Expo Center office staff.

### **Reservations and Payments:**

- Reservations can be made and paid for through ROVERPASS.com or the Enumclaw Expo Center website (enumclawexpo.com.)
- Payment must be made before entering a campsite.
- Fees for extra vehicles, firewood, and vehicle washing may be made to the Camp Host.
- Having trouble making your online reservation? Contact the Camp Host or the Enumclaw Expo center office staff and we will assist you.

### **Reservation Duration:**

- The reservation is 1-7 consecutive days.
- Book a 7-night stay and your 7<sup>th</sup> night is free! (\*Offer excludes holiday weeks regular rates apply to all nights.)
- You may make a second reservation of 1-7 consecutive days if you need to stay more than seven consecutive nights.

- If you need to stay more than 14 consecutive nights, approval must be acquired by the Camp Host or Enumclaw Expo Center Management.
- Memorial Day, Fourth of July, and Labor Day all have a two-night minimum.

**Check-in:**

- Check-in begins at 1pm.
- Check-in before 9:00pm is greatly appreciated.
- Early check-in is available with pre-approval from Camp Host or Enumclaw Expo Center office staff.
- No need to check in with the Camp Host unless you have questions.
- Your check-in date is the first day of your reservation.

**Check-out:**

- Please check out of your campsite by 12pm or earlier.
- Your check-out date is the last day listed on your reservation; you are not charged for that night.
- Late departure is available with pre-approval from the Camp Host or the Enumclaw Expo Center office staff.
  - \$10 fee between 12pm and 2pm.
  - After 2pm a full night's stay will be charged.

**Cancellation Policy:**

- There is a \$10 + rover pass applicable fees for cancellation for all reservation cancellations.
- 50% of the reservation is non-refundable between 72-24 hours before check-in.
- 100% of the reservation is non-refundable for cancellations within 24 hours before check-in.

**Occupancy limits:**

- Each campsite is limited to one RV or two tents (tents allowed between Memorial Day and Labor Day only). No discounts for camping.
- Each campsite is limited to eight (8) registered people.
- Other than your RV, one other vehicle is permitted.
- Your RV and one vehicle must fit on the asphalt pad with no wheels on the grass (see Camp Host for parking options).

**Quiet Hours:**

- Quiet hours are 10pm to 7am.
- Quiet hours may be extended to 11pm during special events.
- Please, no generator use during quiet times. In the case of a power outage in the campground, generators may be used during quiet times.
- We reserve the right to ask guests to leave the campground for excessive noise or disruptive behavior anytime of the day or night.

**Pet Policy:**

- Up to two dogs are allowed. Pre-approval from Camp Host or office staff is required for more than two dogs.
- Indoor only cats or cats on leash are allowed above and beyond the dog limit.
- All pets must be declared at registration.
- All dogs must always be on a leash.
- All pet waste must be cleaned and disposed of in a garbage receptacle. Pet waste bags are provided at the front and back of the campground.
- Please keep pets from walking on other guests' campsites.
- Aggressive or disruptive pets may be asked to vacate the campground.

**Fire Pits:**

- Open fires are subject to local fire bans and should be monitored for compliance.
- Gas fire pits are permitted on the asphalt.
- Open fires and gas fire pits are not allowed on the grass.

**Alcohol:**

- Open containers are allowed only within your campsite, in accordance with state and local laws.
- Guests are required to maintain a neat and orderly campsite.
- All garbage, including cigarette butts, must be disposed of properly before leaving the campsite.
- Pet waste should be cleaned up immediately.
- Prohibited items include tarps, clotheslines, excessive plastic bins, and trash.
- Any damage to campsites will be charged to the guest.

- Disposal of large items such as mattresses, plastic bins, or canopies will be subject to additional fees. All boxes must be broken down before disposing of them in recycle bins.

#### **Campsite Cleanliness:**

- Guests are required to maintain a neat and orderly campsite.
- All garbage, including cigarette butts, must be disposed of properly before leaving the campsite.
- Pet waste should be cleaned up immediately.
- Prohibited items include tarps, clotheslines, excessive plastic bins, and trash.
- Any damage to campsites will be charged to the guest.
- Disposal of large items such as mattresses, plastic bins, or canopies will be subject to additional fees. All boxes must be broken down before disposing of them in recycle bins.

#### **Tank Disposal:**

- Dumping of gray or black tanks is prohibited on the campground premises.
- Guests found dumping tanks on the premises will be asked to leave the campground immediately and a \$500 non-negotiable fee will be charged. Visit the campground's bulletin board for names and addresses of nearby dump stations.

#### **Children:**

- We love seeing children in the campground; however, we ask that children be always supervised.
- Showers and restrooms are located on the premises; see Camp Host for the code to access them.
- A portable restroom is located at the back of the campground.
- Garbage and recycling receptacles are located under cover at the back of the campground.
- A soda machine with soda, water, and other drinks is located at the back of the campground.
- ADA campsites are available. Sites 4 and 17 are reserved for guests with proof of disability. Unless pre-approved, these sites are only for eligible guests. Proof of disability is required when reserving. The Camp Host may relocate guests who do not meet these criteria. Unauthorized parking in ADA spaces is a gross misdemeanor with a \$250 fine.

#### **On-site Amenities:**

- Showers and restrooms are located on the premises; see Camp Host for the code to access them.
- A portable restroom is located at the back of the campground.
- Garbage and recycling receptacles are located under cover at the back of the campground.
- A soda machine with soda, water, and other drinks is located at the back of the campground.
- ADA campsites are available. Sites 4 and 17 are reserved for guests with proof of disability. Unless pre-approved, these sites are only for eligible guests. Proof of disability is required when reserving. The Camp Host may relocate guests who do not meet these criteria. Unauthorized parking in ADA spaces is a gross misdemeanor with a \$250 fine.

**Visitors:**

We understand that inviting visitors to your campsite is exciting; however, we do have a few guidelines to follow.

- All visitors must park in the field to the right of the entrance to the campground.
- All visitors must follow campground rules.
- All visitors shall vacate the campground at 10pm (or 11pm on night's quiet time has been extended for special events.)
- If a visitor is staying overnight at your campsite, they must be declared to the Camp Host.

**Mail and Package Delivery:**

- Guests may not use the Enumclaw Expo Center office or campground for mail or package delivery.
- See Camp Host for options available.
