Exhibitor Barn/Farm Usage Contract

Objective: To provide exhibitors the necessary guidelines and instructions for maintaining a healthy and quality market animal project.

Exhibitor Requirements

CLEANING: Exhibitors are expected to maintain healthy living conditions and a clean environment for their animals as well as the entire barn structure by fulfilling the following expectations:

1. **Pens are to be cleaned every day.**
2. Aisles and floors are to be swept every time!
3. **Manure is to be disposed of properly.**
4. Equipment and tools are to be put back in its proper location
5. Exhibitors are also required to assist in manure removal as scheduled.

FEED/WATER: Exhibitors are to provide the proper nutritional requirements necessary for their animals to achieve market weight. This will be accomplished by:

1. Animals will be fed/watered twice daily (check automatic water)
2. **Adhering to group feeding schedules**
3. Purchasing own feed if needed

Assistance: Leaders/Advisors will provide the exhibitor and his/her project with the following:

1. Access to the proper bedding, container for manure removal and a functional facility.
2. Necessary assistance with nutrition, parturition, and vaccination programs.
3. The teaching of sound livestock management practices.
