The KING WILLIAM FAIR PROCEEDS

Proceeds from the KING WILLIAM FAIR provide 95% of the KING WILLIAM ASSOCIATION'S OPERATING FUNDS and have enabled us to INVEST in our SAN ANTONIO COMMUNITY through the following programs:

- The 2024 KING WILLIAM ASSOCIATION GRANT PROGRAM awarded \$68,700 to America's Walking Club; Bonham PTA, Jump Start and Friends of Bonham; Brackenridge High School Theater, Library, Cross Country, Football, Soccer, Dance and ROTC; The Cannoli Fund; Contemporary at Blue Star; Footbridge Foundation; Gardopia Gardens; Hermann Sons Ballroom; San Antonio Art League & Museum, San Antonio Mennonitte Church; and San Antonio River Foundation. The KWA Grant Program has awarded close to \$800,000 since 2001.
- COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENTS including tree planting, public park and sidewalk enhancements, graffiti abatement, San Antonio River amenities, King William Cultural Arts District, and more.
- FREE CONCERTS IN THE PARK bringing together the San Antonio community to enjoy the best in live, local entertainment.
- HOMEOWNER ASSISTANCE FUND keeping residents in their home by funding an income-based repair fund for small emergencies such as tree limb falls, burst pipes, electrical issues, etc.










