ENTRY AND EXHIBITS

- Entry form deadline: AUGUST 16 (After August 16th late fees will apply.)
- Required forms: Hold Harmless Waiver and Horse Barn Rules – Top 5.
- **ALL EXHIBITORS MUST PURCHASE AN EXHIBITOR PASS**
- **All exhibitors** must enter: breed class, Herdsmanship, barn decorations, and educational displays.
- Vet check-in: 1:30-3:00 pm, Wednesday prior to fair.
- All late entries, registrations verification, stall assignments and building capacity are decided by the Director.
- All horses are shown at **halter only**.

HORSE SHOW RULES

Draft Horse - Light Horse - 4-H Horse Show Rules

1. Horses that appear unsound and/or ill will be excused from Show Ring.
2. Horse and handler must be at gate and ready to enter Show Ring at class time. NO EXCEPTIONS (unless approved by Superintendent/Director)
3. Handler must wear number assigned to horse (not exhibitor number). Improper # will result in horse NOT being judged or placed.
4. If judge feels horse or horses do not meet standards of the breed, the judge will not award ribbons.

5. Unsportsmanlike conduct by handler and/or owner will result in horse being dismissed from show, and any ribbon or awards given will be disallowed. Abuse to horse will cause owner/handler to be dismissed from show.
6. Any ill-mannered horse will be excused from Show Ring at judge's discretion and will not be placed.
7. Each horse must be shown in only one horse breed category. If horse is registered in more than one breed registry, you must choose only one.
8. After entry deadline, there will be absolutely NO changes. You must bring the horse you entered before the entry deadline.

LIGHT HORSE RULES

1. Ages will be compiled to the first day of January to determine class.
2. Animals exhibited in this division must be free from physical blemish or disease that is capable of being transmitted in breeding.
3. No individual health certificates prior to entry are required, but Fair veterinary personnel must write a blanket health certificate certifying that all animals in each class have been examined and found free from symptoms of contagious or infectious diseases.
4. Each exhibitor shall be limited to two entries.
5. All horses to be shown shall be properly fitted and in show condition.
6. Only horses that are fully registered in their respective Breed association are eligible to compete. Animals are eligible to compete in only one class.

CLASS 01 - Barn Decorations

Barn Decorations must **be entered by each individual exhibitor**, and give information about exhibitor, ranch, project, breed, etc.

Display exhibitor name clearly (name on entry form) from both barn directions-so judges can identify upon entering barn. Decorations should pertain to Fair Theme.

CLASS 01 - Educational Display

Barn displays must be in place by Wednesday 8 pm. Display topic should be of an educational nature. The size may range from poster to barn/booth display. The display may include sound, motion, mobile and 3-D, etc. Put exhibitors name, age group, and address on back of posters. Posters must be readable from 10 feet away.

BEST OF SHOW AWARD

A Best of Show Ribbon will be awarded to the outstanding horse of the entire show. ONLY the Champions of Divisions 03-A through 03-V will compete for this award.
