OPEN SHEEP RULES

1. All Sheep must have an official **USDA National Scrapie Eradication Program** assigned Flock Identification tag.
2. Ewes 2 years or over to be eligible to show must have produced a lamb within 12 months preceding the show. When demanded by the superintendent, an affidavit must be made by the exhibitor, or ewe shall be declared ineligible to compete.

3. Rams 2 years or over must have sired lambs within 12 months preceding the show; when demanded by the superintendent, affidavit to this effect must be made by exhibitor, or ram will be declared ineligible to show.
4. All registered sheep must be flock tagged and tag # to match registration papers.
5. No more than two (2) animals can be entered, per class, in classes Division 05-A-F, Classes 01-06.
6. Washing of slick shorn sheep only at the fairgrounds is permitted.
7. Open Division Sheep exhibitors may ultrasound their breeding sheep to measure loin eye, at cost, if ultrasound is available at Fair and is scheduled and approved by the superintendent.
8. Breeding sheep entered in Department 05- Open Sheep cannot be cross entered in Department 53-4H/FFA Sheep
9. Breeding Sheep Awards. All breeding sheep entered in the Department 05-Open Sheep, Class 01 through 06, will be shown with breeding sheep entered in 4H/FFA Sheep Department, Breeding Sheep entered in Department 53-4H/FFA Sheep, Class 01 through Class 06.

CLASSES

- 01 -Ram, 2 years old and over
- 02 -Ram, 1 year old and under 2
- 03 -Ram lamb, under 1 year
- 04 -Ewe, 2 years old or over
- 05 -Ewe, 1 year and under 2
- 06 -Ewe lamb, under 1 year

GROUP AND SPECIALTY CLASSES

- 07 - Produce of ewe, consists of two individuals, any age, either sex, bred by exhibitor.
- 08 - Get of sire, consists of four individuals, any age, either sex from by the same sire, bred by the exhibitor.
- 09 - Breeder’s pen consists of pen of four animals, either sex, bred by exhibitor.
- 10 - Flock consists of one ram, any age; and three females, all owned by exhibitor; and of the all same breed.
