#### ENTRY AND EXHIBITS

- Entry form deadline: AUGUST 16 (After 8/16 late fees will apply.)
- OPEN DIVISION FARM CROP EXHIBITS DISPLAYED IN 4-H/FFA BUILDING
- Hay and Grain will be received in the 4-H Building from 4:00 pm - 6:00 pm on Monday prior to Fair.

#### HAY, GRAIN & FORAGE RULES

1. All products exhibited must have been grown in Kittitas County during the 2020 season.
2. Like products must be assembled at one place at the time of judging.
3. All sheaf displays of hay and grain must be in bundles, tied at three places and not less than three inches in diameter at the butt; leave all stems and leaves.
4. Must have a sign to explain display.
5. LIMIT: ONE ENTRY PER CLASS
6. Read General Rules & Regulations.

#### DIVISION 13-A ..... SHEAF GRAIN

##### PREMIUM POINTS

Blue ..... 35

Red ..... 20

##### CLASSES

- 01 - Hard red wheat
- 02 - Soft white spring
- 03 - Soft white winter
- 04 - Any other variety of wheat
- 05 - Oats, any variety
- 06 - Barley, any variety
- 07 - Any other not listed

#### DIVISION 13-B ..... THRESHED GRAIN ..... 1 QUART

##### PREMIUM POINTS

Blue ..... 25

Red ..... 10

##### CLASSES

- 01 - Soft white wheat
- 02 - Hard red wheat
- 03 - Any other variety of wheat
- 04 - Oats, any variety
- 05 - Barley
- 06 - Any other not listed

#### DIVISION 13-C ..... SHEAF HAY CROPS

##### PREMIUM POINTS

Blue ..... 35

Red ..... 20

##### CLASSES

- 01 - Five sheaves, 3 varieties or more assembled in-group.
- 02 - Sheaf Alfalfa
- 03 - Sheaf Timothy
- 04 - Sheaf Orchard Grass
- 05 - Sudan Grass
- 06 - Mixed Grass, bundled (mixture of grasses)
- 07 - Grass, bundled any other not listed

#### DIVISION 13-D ..... BALED HAY CROPS

##### PREMIUM POINTS

Blue ..... 35

Red ..... 20

##### CLASSES

- 01 - Alfalfa Hay, first cut-1 bale
- 02 - Alfalfa Hay, second cut-1 bale
- 03 - Timothy Hay, first cut-1 bale
- 04 - Timothy Hay, second cut-1 bale
- 05 - Mixed Hay, 1 bale (grass & legume)
- 06 - Grain Hay, 1 bale
- 07 - Sudan Hay, 1 bale
- 08 - Any other not listed
- 09 - Orchard Grass, 1 bale

**DIVISION 13-E .....OPEN HAY, GRAIN, FORAGE  
EDUCATIONAL DISPLAY**

Space is limited. Pre-register by calling the Superintendent, so space can be incorporated into the Department area.

- Create a display on a topic of educational value related to the Department.
- History, How-to, Compare and Contrast, New Developments, etc. are all appropriate prompts for an educational display.
- Display may include sound, motion, 3-D, etc.
- Use large lettering to convey the main message. All wording should be readable from 6 feet away.
- All content must be original and copyright free.

**Class 01 – Large Open Educational Display**

Large Display: Maximum 20 square feet combined horizontal and vertical space (e.g. tri-fold display board on top of your own card table) down to 6 square feet (combined horizontal and vertical)

**PREMIUM POINTS**

**Blue** .....60

**Red** .....40

**White** .....20

**Class 02 – Small Open Educational Display**

Small Display: size allowed up to 24" x 36" maximum (combined horizontal and vertical), down to 11" x 17" minimum.

**PREMIUM POINTS**

**Blue** .....45

**Red** .....30

**White** .....15
