OPEN BAKING RULES

- Baking entered will be judged according to the degree of difficulty.
- 2. ONLY ONE ENTRY PER CLASS ALLOWED.
- 3. Regular size is encouraged. One half of item plus one slice is required for cakes and breads. One half of a 8–9-inch pie, cut into four slices preferred.
- 4. At the judge's discretion, duplicated foods will not be judged.
- All baked foods will be judged on general appearance, quality, flavor and texture, and suitability of the food item entered.
- 6. Please note the requirements for each Division.
- Food items entered in the Baking Department will be disposed of at the close of Fair.

- Create a display on a topic of educational value related to the Department.
- History, How-to, Compare and Contrast, New Developments, etc. are all appropriate prompts for an educational display.
- Display may include sound, motion, 3-D, etc.
- Use large lettering to convey the main message. All wording should be readable from 6 feet away.
- All content must be original and copyright free.

Class 01 - Large Open Educational Display

Large Display: Maximum 20 square feet combined horizontal and vertical space (e.g., tri-fold display board on top of your own card table) down to 6 square feet (combined horizontal and vertical)

Class 02 - Small Open Educational Display

Small Display: size allowed up to $24'' \times 36''$ maximum (combined horizontal and vertical), down to $11'' \times 17''$ minimum.
