#### ENTRY AND EXHIBITS

- Entry form deadline: AUGUST 16 (After 8/16 late fees will apply.)
- Entries accept at the Home Arts Building, Monday prior to Fair at 10:00am-7:00pm
- All items must remain on display until the close of Fair, 6:00 pm Monday, Labor Day. Pick up your ribbon and comment card between 6:00pm and 8:00 pm on that day in Baking Department.

#### OPEN YOUTH BAKING RULES

1. Open to Youth (ages 18 and under).
2. Indicate AGE of exhibitor for Youth entry.
3. **ONLY ONE ENTRY PER CLASS ALLOWED.**
4. Baking entered will be judged according to the degree of difficulty.
5. Regular size is encouraged. One half of item plus one slice is required for cakes and breads.
6. With the exception of Division 19-B (Decorated Cakes), no commercially prepared mixes may be used.
7. At the judge's discretion, duplicated foods will not be judged.
8. All baked foods will be judged on general appearance, quality, flavor and texture, and suitability of the food item entered.
9. Please note the requirements for each DIVISION.
10. Food items entered in the Baking Department will be disposed of at the close of Fair.

#### DIVISION 19-A .....CAKES BAKED BY YOUTH

(Enter ½ of 8" cake plus a slice)

#### PREMIUM POINTS

Blue ..... 15

Red ..... 10

White ..... 5

#### CLASSES

- 01 - White layer cake
- 02 - Chocolate layer cake
- 03 - Cupcakes (3)
- 04 - Angel food cake (un-iced)
- 05 - Any other not listed

#### DIVISION 19-B .....DECORATED CAKES

Decorations must be edible. Exception will be when dolls are used. The cake itself can be from a mix, judging is focused on the decorating.

#### PREMIUM POINTS

Blue ..... 15

Red ..... 10

White ..... 5

#### CLASSES

- 01 - Holiday
- 02 - Novelty
- 03 - Fair Themed
- 04 - Decorated Cake Form

#### DIVISION 19-C .....COOKIES & CANDIES

(3 of each on a small plate)

#### PREMIUM POINTS

Blue ..... 15

Red ..... 10

White ..... 5

#### CLASSES

- 01 - Brownies
- 02 - Bar cookies
- 03 - Drop cookies
- 04 - Rolled and cut
- 05 - No-bake cookies
- 06 - Refrigerator cookies

- 07 - Rolled in a ball  
 08 - Decorated cookies  
 09 - Any other cookie not listed  
 10 - Fudge candy  
 11- Any other candy not listed

**DIVISION 19-D ..... SWEET BREADS**

(½ loaf plus a slice)

**PREMIUM POINTS**

Blue .....15  
 Red .....10  
 White .....5

**CLASSES**

- 01 - Quick Bread (loaf) Pumpkin, zucchini, etc.  
 02 - Cinnamon Rolls (3)  
 03 - Coffee cake or tea ring (small)  
 04 – Muffins  
 05 - Any other not listed

**DIVISION 19-E ..... BREAD, ROLLS,  
 BISCUITS**

(½ loaf plus a slice)

**PREMIUM POINTS**

Blue .....15  
 Red .....10  
 White .....5

**CLASSES**

- 01 - White bread  
 02 - Whole wheat bread  
 03 - Parkerhouse rolls (3)  
 04 - Yeast rolls (3)  
 05 - Biscuits (3)  
 07 - Any other not listed

**DIVISION 19-F ..... A BUDDY & ME**

**For Youth 8 Years and Under**

This Division is especially for a young child and their Buddy (acting as a mentor) to do baking together. Several children may have the same adult buddy to help, and each child will enter separately. *Adults enter SEPARATELY in Adult Baking Department 18.*

**PREMIUM POINTS**

Blue .....10  
 Red .....8  
 White .....5

**CLASSES**

- 01 - Quick Bread (loaf) Pumpkin, zucchini, etc.  
 02 - Cinnamon Rolls (3)

**03 - Coffee cake or tea ring (small)**

**DIVISION 19-G .....OPEN YOUTH BAKING  
 EDUCATIONAL DISPLAY**

Space is limited. Pre-register by calling the Superintendent, so space can be incorporated into the Department area.

- Create a display on a topic of educational value related to the Department.
- History, How-to, Compare and Contrast, New Developments, etc. are all appropriate prompts for an educational display.
- Display may include sound, motion, 3-D, etc.
- Use large lettering to convey the main message. All wording should be readable from 6 feet away.
- All content must be original and copyright free.

**Class 01 – Large Open Educational Display**

Large Display: Maximum 20 square feet combined horizontal and vertical space (e.g. tri-fold display board on top of your own card table) down to 6 square feet (combined horizontal and vertical)

**PREMIUM POINTS**

Blue ..... 60  
 Red ..... 40  
 White ..... 20

**Class 02 – Small Open Educational Display**

Small Display: size allowed up to 24" x 36" maximum (combined horizontal and vertical), down to 11" x 17" minimum.

**PREMIUM POINTS**

Blue ..... 45  
 Red ..... 30  
 White ..... 15
