OPEN YOUTH BAKING RULES

- 1. Open to Youth (ages 18 and under).
- 2. Indicate AGE of exhibitor for Youth entry.
- 3. ONLY ONE ENTRY PER CLASS ALLOWED.
- 4. Baking entered will be judged according to the degree of difficulty.
- 5. Regular size is encouraged. One half of item plus one slice is required for cakes and breads. One half of an 8–9-inch pie cut into four pieces, preferred.
- 6. At the judge's discretion, duplicated foods will not be judged.
- All baked foods will be judged on general appearance, quality, flavor and texture, and suitability of the food item entered.
- 8. Please note the requirements for each DIVISION.
- 9. Food items entered in the Baking Department will be disposed of at the close of Fair.

Large Display: Maximum 20 square feet combined horizontal and vertical space (e.g., tri-fold display board on top of your own card table) down to 6 square feet (combined horizontal and vertical)
