1. Needlework will be judged according to the degree of difficulty.
2. **No plastic canvas items accepted in Needlework Division (see Department 30, Adult Crafts and Hobbies)**
3. Items should be blocked, pressed, clean and free of animal hair and all foreign objects.
4. **Identify your level of skill by marking whether you are a Beginner, Intermediate, Advanced or youth exhibitor.**
5. Please refer to additional Open Home Arts rules.
6. Two entries per class

**DIVISION 26-I.....OPEN NEEDLEWORK  
EDUCATIONAL DISPLAY**

- Create a display on a topic of educational value related to the Department.
- History, How-to, Compare and Contrast, New Developments, etc. are all appropriate prompts for an educational display.
- Display may include sound, motion, 3-D, etc.
- Use large lettering to convey the main message. All wording should be readable from 6 feet away.
- All content must be original and copyright free.

**Class 01 – Large Open Educational Display**

Large Display: Maximum 20 square feet combined horizontal and vertical space (e.g., tri-fold display board on top of your own card table) down to 6 square feet (combined horizontal and vertical)

**PREMIUM POINTS**

**Blue** .....60

**Red** .....40

**White** .....20

**Class 02 – Small Open Educational Display**

Small Display: size allowed up to 24" x 36" maximum (combined horizontal and vertical), down to 11" x 17" minimum.

**PREMIUM POINTS**

**Blue** .....45

**Red** .....30

**White** .....15
