OPEN SEWING RULES

1. Articles will be judged according to the degree of difficulty, appearance and workmanship.
2. Items should be pressed and in new condition. Articles that are soiled or damaged will not be accepted. **All exhibits will have been made since last Fair and made by exhibitor.**
3. Two entries under each class allowed. Sewing machine art: one entry per class in Departments 27-F, 27-G, 27-H.

DIVISION 27-A SEWING BY YOUTH

(18 years and under) *Each article must have an attached CARE LABEL*, written on a piece of paper or card giving care instructions.

DIVISION 27-B A BUDDY & ME For Youth 8 Years and Under

This Division is especially for a young child and their Buddy (acting as a mentor) to do sewing together. Several children may have the same adult buddy to help, and each child will enter separately. Project must be primarily the work of the child. Adults enter Adult Sewing on their own form.

SEWING MACHINE ART

DIVISION 27-G FREE MOTION

Limited to work done FREE MOTION on a sewing machine designed for normal sewing.

DIVISION 27-HNON-FREE MOTION OR PROGRAMMED STITCHES

Work done with a sewing machine designed for normal sewing, or on special embellishment machines, or with an embroidery machine, using any of the machine's available stitches (programmed stitches, cams or computer cassettes).

DIVISION 27-I PROFESSIONAL

Professional is defined as any person who receives pay for teaching classes for specific techniques or who sells their work.

- 01 -Thread Painting, Straight Stitch
- 02 -Thread Painting, Side Stitch
- 03 -Thread Painting, Combination of Straight & Side Stitch

- 08 -Beading
- 09 -Multi-Media (hand painted background with thread enhancement, stamping, dying, etc.)
- 10 -Manipulated Fabric Design (i.e. wrinkling, pleating, tucking, smocking, etc.)
- 11 -Free Motion Embroidery (Luny used in Crewel Designs, 3-D objects, self-made fabrics)
- 12 -Silk Ribbon by Machine
- 13 -Recycle object used in machine embroidery
- 14 -Free Motion Quilting
- 15 -Applique'
- 16 -Other Technique (stitching through metal, roving, tea bags, other unusual objects, etc.)

DIVISION 27-JOTHER SMALL SEWN ITEMS

Item such as costumes or any other item that does not fit in categories listed above.

- 01 - Doll Dresses or Other Doll Outfit
- 02 - Other garments from pre-cut fabric panel (Items that come “preprinted” on fabric then are cut out and constructed)
- 03 - Table Cloth
- 04 -Set of 4 Placemats or 4 Napkins
- 05 -Table Runner
- 06 -Clothing accessories or miscellaneous sewn non-clothing (kites, small flags, book bags, back-packs, etc.)
- 07 -Item made from Recycled Fabric (Recycled fabric would be (as example) apron made from a flour sack or blue jeans.
- 08 - Other Household Items
- 09 - Any Other Not Listed

**DIVISION 27-KOPEN SEWING
 EDUCATIONAL DISPLAY**

- Create a display on a topic of educational value related to the Department.
- History, How-to, Compare and Contrast, New Developments, etc. are all appropriate prompts for an educational display.
- Display may include sound, motion, 3-D, etc.
- Use large lettering to convey the main message. All wording should be readable from 6 feet away.
- All content must be original and copyright free.

Class 01 – Large Open Educational Display

Large Display: Maximum 20 square feet combined horizontal and vertical space (e.g. tri-fold display board on top of your own card table) down to 6 square feet (combined horizontal and vertical)

Class 02 – Small Open Educational Display

Small Display: size allowed up to 24” x 36” maximum (combined horizontal and vertical), down to 11” x 17” minimum.
