ENTRY AND EXHIBITS

- Entry form deadline: Third Friday in August by 5pm
- Quilts will be physically accepted in the Armory building (Room "B") Monday August 21st, between 12:00 pm-5:00 pm.
- All exhibits remain on display until the close of Fair, 6:00 pm Monday, Labor Day. Quilts MUST be picked up on Monday, Labor Day between 6:00 pm and 8:00 pm ONLY.

OPEN QUILT RULES

- Quilts will be judged according to the degree of difficulty.
- 2. Quilts must have been completed in the last year.
- 3. Identify your level of skill by marking whether you are a Beginner, Intermediate, or Advanced Quilter.
- 4. List age group: Youth (18 years and under), Adult or Senior Citizen.
- 5. Heirloom quilts may be entered for display only if space is available.
- 6. Names must be covered.
- 7. Please give size of quilt on a piece of paper and attach to back of quilt.
- 8. Only one entry under each Class.
- 9. Quilts must be clean and free of odors.
- 10. Superintendents have the authority to refuse any item that does not conform to the rules.

DIVISION 28-G OPEN QUILTS EDUCATIONAL DISPLAY

- Create a display on a topic of educational value related to the Department.
- History, How-to, Compare and Contrast, New Developments, etc. are all appropriate prompts for an educational display.
- Display may include sound, motion, 3-D, etc.
- Use large lettering to convey the main message. All wording should be readable from 6 feet away.
- All content must be original and copyright free.

Class 01 – Large Open Educational Display

Large Display: Maximum 20 square feet combined horizontal and vertical space (e.g. tri-fold display board on top of your own card table) down to 6 square feet (combined horizontal and vertical)

Class 02 – Small Open Educational Display

Small Display: size allowed up to $24'' \times 36''$ maximum (combined horizontal and vertical), down to $11'' \times 17''$ minimum.
