ENTRY AND EXHIBITS

- Entry form deadline: Third Friday of August by 5pm
- **Entries physically accepted at the Home Arts Building, Friday prior to Fair from 10:00 am – 7:00 pm ONLY.**
- **All exhibits remain on display until the close of Fair, 6:00 pm Monday, Labor Day. All entries must then be picked up between 6:00 pm and 8:00 pm on Monday, Labor Day, in the Home Arts building.**

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OPEN YOUTH ARTS, CRAFTS & HOBBIES RULES

1. 18 years and under
2. All articles must be original work of the exhibitor and completed within the last two years. Exhibits entered and judged in previous Kittitas County Fairs will not be accepted.
3. *The Superintendent/Director shall have the right to reclassify items if needed.*
4. *Superintendents/Director and/or Judges reserve the right to reject work based on size, fragility, inappropriate content, or other rule infringements.*
5. All possible care will be taken to safeguard the entries, however, no responsibility will be assumed for damage or loss to entries while on exhibit. The exhibitor can help protect their piece by providing appropriate stands, displays and mountings when needed. Any piece that falls apart will not be judged or displayed.
6. Each entry should come ready for display.

7. Please include age of exhibitor on entry tag. Any youth deserving special consideration for judging purposes should have a "SC" on their entry tag next to their age.
8. **Because of space limitations exhibitors may only enter three (3) exhibits per DIVISION with a maximum of Twelve (12) entries total in this Department.**
9. We ask that ALL entries be smaller than an 18"x18"x18" area. Oversized items need to be approved prior to entry by either the Director or Superintendent in charge.
10. Special rules pertaining to any specific Division in this Department must be adhered to. Any questions regarding a specific rule must be asked of the Director or Superintendent in charge before entry is submitted.
11. Exhibits should come ready to hang, and be mounted on foam board. **For safety reasons glass frames are not permitted.** Exhibits should also come with plastic stock hangers attached to the work.
12. The Lego design should not exceed the size of the baseplate (10" X 10"). The height of the Lego entry should not exceed 12" in height. Prior approval must be made with Director or Superintendent for entries larger than the dimensions outlined above (10"W, 10"L, 12"H). **All Lego entries must be mounted on a Lego baseplate and foam board.**

DIVISION 38-CORIGINAL ART

- Final art pieces are not to exceed 2x3’ feet. This includes the matting, if used.
- ***Frames are no longer be accepted. Please mount your art piece on some sort of hard backing,*** foam core is frequently used and can be purchased from local area stores. Matting and shrink wrap may also be used to help protect art piece. Equip piece with a hanging tab on back to allow for displaying on our peg board and hook system. *No tape and/or string will be accepted.* Any piece that falls apart will not be judged or displayed. Entries that do not abide by this rule will not be accepted.
- The Superintendent or Director has the right to reject any piece that does not meet with these requirements.

- Firm bases are requested for models built out of pieces such as, Lego, K-Nex, and Lincoln Logs, or any entry that needs the extra support. Entries will be moved prior to the Fair’s opening, and although precautions will be used, it is up to the exhibitor to ensure their piece will not fall apart. Any piece that falls apart will not be judged or displayed. (con’t next column)
- All projects must fit within size restrictions of 18”x 18” x 18”. Please check with Superintendent or Director concerning oversized pieces.

DIVISION 38-JCOLLECTIONS

- All Collections must be securely mounted or anchored in a container suitable for display.
- All collections must be accompanied by a 3”x 5” inch card containing legible information about the background and/or origin of the collection.
- Mounted and Labeled collections (CLASS 01-03) are not restricted in number of items in the collection.
- Related Articles (CLASS 04-06) are restricted to ten (10) pieces or under.
- Please check with Superintendent or Director about questions or concerns in this Division.

DIVISION 38-LYOUTH GROUP PROJECTS

PREMIUM POINTS

1. Youth groups include, but are not limited to: Brownies, Camp Fire, Girl Scouts, Boy Scouts, Child care centers, Pre-Schools.
2. All exhibitors must be members of a Youth Group.
3. All articles entered for judging must have been made during this previous year either at a group meeting, camp or some type of group function, and be the work of the exhibitor(s).
4. All entries must adhere to the size restrictions in this division, 18 x18 x 18 inches. Please call the Superintendent or Director if you need a size exception. We will try our best to work with you.
5. Exhibits are limited to ONE entry per Class.

DIVISION 38-M OPEN YOUTH ARTS, CRAFTS AND HOBBIES EDUCATIONAL DISPLAY

- Create a display on a topic of educational value related to the Department.
- History, How-to, Compare and Contrast, New Developments, etc. are all appropriate prompts for an educational display.
- Display may include sound, motion, 3-D, etc.
- Use large lettering to convey the main message. All wording should be readable from 6 feet away.
- All content must be original and copyright free.

Class 01 – Large Open Educational Display

Large Display: Maximum 20 square feet combined horizontal and vertical space (e.g. tri-fold display board on top of your own card table) down to 6 square feet (combined horizontal and vertical)

Class 02 – Small Open Educational Display

Small Display: size allowed up to 24” x 36” maximum (combined horizontal and vertical), down to 11” x 17” minimum.
