ENTRY AND EXHIBITS

- Entry form deadline: Third Friday of August at 5pm
- Please bring, and pick up your entry(s) during the times listed below, in the Armory Building
 - Physically accepted Friday prior to Fair from: • 10:00 am - 7:00 pm
 - Released: Monday, Labor Day 6:00 pm 8:00 pm

OPEN PHOTOGRAPHY RULES

- Photographs must be the work of the exhibitor, however 1. processing and printing; matting and mounting may be commercially done.
- Photos entered in previous years are not eligible. 2.
- 3. Photos must have been taken within the last 2 years prior to Fair.
- Exhibitors may enter up to two (2) photos per class. Total 4. entries may not exceed 8 for Department 40.
- 5. All photos are exhibited at owner's risk.
- 6. The Superintendent/Director shall have the right to reclassify items into an appropriate Division or Class if needed.
- 7. Superintendents/Director and/or Judges reserve the right to reject work based on size, fragility, inappropriate content, or other rule infringements.
- Danish System: Photographs will be judged on own 8. merit, not against another photo.

INFORMATION FOR PHOTOGRAPH ENTRIES

- 1. Image sizes allowed: minimum size 8"x10", 8.5"x11", 8"x12" 11"x14", or 11"x16" and panoramic print sizes 4"x12" or 5"x15".
- 2. Foam core mounting is required on all entries. No frames or glass are allowed, photos can be matted and have shrink-wrap for added protection if desired.
- 3. A plastic or fabric adhesive hanging tab should be mounted on the back of photo entry. Tabs need to allow a hook to be passed through it for hanging photo on our pegboard displays. No metal.
- 4. Finished photo entry may not exceed 16"x20" including mat. ONLY EXCEPTION: Collage entries can have a maximum size of 25"x30".
- OTOGRAPHY Please have photo entry ready to be exhibited prior to 5. check-in. Superintendents are available in advance to help with questions regarding your entry. Please check with our local photography dealers for assistance prior t ${f \overline{a}}$ bringing your entry into the Fair.
- Please have name, address, and phone number on back 6. of entry. 4
- 7.
- Name and/or signature of exhibitor may not be showing on the front of finished piece. Photographs that do not comply with these rules will not be accepted. 8.

PHOTOGRAPHY JUDGES SCORE CRITERIA

1. IMPACT - 35 PTS.

• Effect on the Viewer. Storytelling quality catches the eye and holds attention.

2. COMPOSITION - 35 PTS.

 Arrangement of the Elements. Contains all the elements, few distracting or unnecessary, and all the elements are arranged to tell the story and lead the eye into the picture.

3. TECHNICAL QUALITY - 20 PTS.

 The photograph is clear & sharp and shows details in areas where appropriate.

4. WORKMANSHIP - 10 PTS.

• Picture is mounted neatly and securely in accordance with requirements.

85-100 pts. = Blue

60-84 pts. = Red

40-59 pts. = White

01 - Portraits / People

Photographs where the primary subject is a person or group of people.

02 - Animals / Wildlife

Photographs in which the subjects are primarily animals.

03 - Floral

Photographs showing the obvious beauty of flowers.

04 - Still Life

Photographs showing interesting and unique still life objects

05 - Architecture

Photographs showing the interesting beauty of architecture.

06 - Scenery / Landscape

Photographs primarily illustrating land, water, or sky.

07 - Alternative / Abstract

All photographs that have had the image intentionally altered in some way, either through double exposure or in the developing/processing of the image. Photos that are printed on canvas or sheet metal, or that are threedimensional (e.g., box or sphere).

Please include for display, an explanation and/or description of what procedures were used to create the final print.

09-Humor

Photographs that are humorous or displaying a humorous event.

10-Action

Photographs that show movement or action.
