1. Dairy check in: between 12:00pm-2:00 pm, in place by 2pm. No animals will be accepted after 2:00 pm, no exceptions. Exhibitors with improper or incomplete paperwork will go to the end of the line.
2. Exhibitors with milking cows must provide milking equipment & milk their cows.

- 05 - Junior Yearling Heifer born Mar. 1 through May 31, of the previous year
- 06 - Senior Yearling Heifer (not in milk) born Sept. 1, through Nov 30 of three years previous
- 07 - Senior Yearling Heifer (freshened) born Sept. 1 through Aug. 31, three years previous
- 08 - Cow (2 yrs. and younger) born Sept. 1, through Feb 28, of two years previous
- 09 - Cow (3 yrs. and under 4) born Sept. 1, through – Aug. 1, three years previous
- 10 - Cow (4 yrs. and under 5) born Sept. 1-Aug 31<sup>st</sup> four years previous
- 11 - Cow (5 yrs. and older) born before Sept 1 of five years previous
- 12 – Cow/calf pair, calf born in current year
