(Jr. Horse Fair horses returning for Labor Day Fair can be added to your herdsmanship entry form after this deadline without late fee.)
- Required forms: Hold Harmless Waiver, Barn Rules & Top 5.

### JUNIOR HORSE FAIR RULES

1. Before they are stalled - horses are to be vet checked by Fair designated veterinarian, THURSDAY AUGUST 18th FROM 7:00 am to 8:30 am at the 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue Gate entrance.
  2. Stall cards need to state Club name and emergency contact.
  3. Horses are to be owned or under lease in accordance with leasing policy established for the 4-H horse project.
  4. Horses are to be shown and ridden by the exhibitor.
- All entries in Divisions 56A through 56P will be shown on August 18-21/2022.**
5. To be eligible to show in the 4-H Divisions, a 4-H member must have filed a horse certificate in the County Extension Office by April 30th of the current year.

6. **Horses 56 inches in height and under** may be shown as ponies in pony performance and equitation divisions if offered. May show in horse divisions but not both. Pony awards are for Pony Divisions only. See awards section for eligibility.
7. **Green Horse Definition:** A green horse will be identified as a horse under 6 years old as of January 1st that has not been shown in a shank bit. English or Western. Walk jog/trot and walk jog/trot, lope/canter.  
  
**Aged Green Horse Definition:** An aged green horse will be identified as a horse 6 years old or older as of January 1st that has not been shown in a shank bit. Horses cannot be shown in aged green horse for more than one year. English or Western: Walk jog/trot and walk jog/trot, lope/canter.  
  
**Horses in Green Horse and Aged Green Horse Divisions** must be ridden in a smooth snaffle at least 3/8" diameter 1" from ring or a bosal with two hands used on the reins. Mechanical hackamores or leverage snaffles are not allowed. When split reins are used they must be crossed and both hands must be on both reins. Green Horse Divisions are only open to Senior and Intermediate 4-H members, which have leader approval. **NO CROSS ENTRIES WITH PERFORMANCE Divisions.**
8. Exhibitors cannot cross enter age riding Divisions with pony Divisions unless they are using a separate horse and pony.
9. PARENT AND LEADER APPROVAL ARE REQUIRED FOR ALL DIVISIONS.
10. All riders must wear SEI equine approved helmets at all times in in-hand trail, when mounted, and in all Divisions except showmanship, although recommended. Novice members of all ages are required to wear helmets in showmanship.
11. Camping on grounds for a nominal fee payable at registration. No exhibitors will be allowed on the grounds overnight without adult supervision.
12. Novice Divisions: Novice members are required to ride in the novice Divisions for the whole year. If they choose to show novice or regular in one Division, they must show the same in all Divisions entered. Any exceptions to novice ruling may be appealed, in writing, to the 4-H Horse Panel. If a new member elects to judge as a novice then they will continue as a novice in contests that offer novice events throughout the year.
13. Medal Classes: No premium points given for medal class. Handler must be Senior or Intermediate 4-H horse member. Must have received a Blue Danish ribbon in showmanship class or respective equitation classes.

14. Ribbons awarded 1st to 10th place in all Divisions. Only ribbons won at the current KCJHF can be displayed.
15. Decorations need to be in place by Thursday at 3:00 pm.
16. Horses cannot be shown by more than one 4-H member without prior approval of the 4-H Horse Panel.
17. Herdsmanship contest will be judged Friday pm, Saturday am, Saturday pm, and Sunday am
18. All Divisions will be held in either Bloom Pavilion or the Rodeo Arena.
19. Exhibitors will be allowed to stall as many horses as exhibitor can care for properly. An additional horse may be used during the games provided it is unloaded and loaded in the same area immediately following the close of the games Divisions.
20. Awards Ceremony to be held approximately ½ hour after the last Division on Sunday.
21. Any protest must be in writing to the Superintendent within 1 hour of Division completion.
22. The exhibitor has important responsibilities prior to Fair time. Flu-Rhino vaccinations should be given no more than 6 weeks and no less than 3 weeks prior to Fair and an effective parasite control program employed. State-of-the-art prophylactic care is strongly recommended for all animals to be exhibited.
