ENTRY AND EXHIBITS

- Entry form deadline: AUGUST 16 (After 8/16 late fees will apply.)
- Required forms: Hold Harmless Waiver and Stall Request.
- **ALL EXHIBITORS MUST PURCHASE AN EXHIBITOR PASS**
- *All clubs must enter: herdsmanship and barn decorations.*
- *Are encouraged to enter Educational Exhibits.*
- Read General Rules & Regulations.
- Read Livestock Guide for general animal rules and requirements.

4H/FFA JUDGING TIMES

Sunday of Fair: Showmanship, Breed 8:30 am.

Thursday of Fair: Costume and Breed ID 2:00 pm

4H CAVY RULES

1. Arrive/vet check:10:00 am – 11:00am, In place no later than 12:00pm Wednesday, NO EXCEPTIONS
2. Mandatory meeting for all Rabbit and Cavy exhibitors on Wednesday 12:00 pm in Bloom.
3. In filling out entry blanks, the exhibitor is expected to state plainly the sex, age, breed, and variety and must show ear tag # on entry form if any.
4. The Fair Association will not be responsible for loss or accident, but will give every care and attention.

Animals deemed unfit by veterinarian due to insects or disease will not be accepted for exhibit.

5. All cavies shall be judged by the Official Show Rules of the American Cavy Breeders Association. The judge will withhold prize when specimens are not of sufficient merit.
6. Advertising and "For Sale" signs are not permitted.
7. All exhibitors are required to be present during judging and will carry their cavy to and from the judging table. Conflicts must be resolved through the superintendent.
8. THE EXHIBITOR WILL PROVIDE THE FEEDERS AND WATERERS.
9. The exhibitor is expected to properly feed and water their cavies.
10. The Superintendent may withhold premiums if the exhibitor fails to care for their exhibit, and/or if its trays are not emptied and washed at close of Fair.
11. All exhibitors must spend time supervising the exhibits in Bloom. Specific times and dates will be posted in the barn.
12. Limited to 6 animal entries per exhibitor.
