### ENTRY AND EXHIBITS

- Entry form deadline: AUGUST 16 (After 8/16 late fees will apply.)
- Required forms: Hold Harmless Waiver and Stall Request
- **All clubs must enter: Herdsmanship Dept 73-Z and Barn Decorations Department 73-U.**
- **ALL EXHIBITORS MUST PURCHASE AN EXHIBITOR PASS**
- All individuals are encouraged to enter Educational Exhibits.

### YOUTH CLUBS RABBITS RULES

1. Rabbits will be accepted for Vet Check-In from 10:00am and 11:00am Wednesday.
2. Mandatory meeting for all Rabbit and Cavy exhibitors on Wednesday at 12:00 pm in Bloom.
3. In filling out entry form, the exhibitor is expected to state plainly the sex, age, breed, and variety, and must show ear tag # on entry form as well.
4. The Fair will not be responsible for loss or accident but will give every care and attention. Animals deemed unfit by the veterinarian due to insects or disease will not be accepted for exhibit.

5. All rabbits shall be judged by the Official Show Rules of the American Rabbit Breeders Association. The judge will withhold prizes when specimens are not of sufficient merit.
6. Advertising and "For Sale" signs are not permitted.
7. All exhibitors are required to be present during judging and will carry their rabbits to and from the judging table.
8. All Exhibitors (Clubs) are responsible for cleaning their cages, feeders, and area under cages every day by 9:00am. Equipment-feed areas should be always kept tidy.
9. THE EXHIBITOR WILL PROVIDE THE RABBIT FEEDERS AND WATERERS. The exhibitor is expected to properly feed and water their rabbits every day by 9:00am.
10. Superintendent may withhold premiums if the exhibitor fails to care for their exhibit, and/or if trays are not emptied and washed at close of Fair.
11. The Superintendent may deny entry to any animal they deem unworthy of public display.
12. All 4-H exhibitors must spend time supervising the exhibits in Bloom. Specific times and duties to be posted in Bloom.
13. No more than five (5) entries per exhibitor.
14. Meat and Type Class cannot be cross-entered.

### SHOW RABBIT DIVISIONS

#### TYPE CLASS

60-A	Junior buck, under 6 months
60-B	Intermediate buck, 6-8 months (6 class breed only)
60-C	Senior buck, over 6 months
60-D	Junior doe, under 6 months
60-E	Intermediate doe, 6-8 months (6 class breed only)
60-F	Senior doe, over 6 months

### CLASSES

- 03 - MEAT RABBIT DIVISIONS

All meat rabbits must have a permanent tattoo. All rabbits will be weighed in the presence of the judge.

**RABBIT PENS WILL BE JUDGED ON:**

Meat Type	40 Points
Condition of Flesh	30 Points
Uniformity of body & weight	20 Points
Fur	10 Points

**DIVISION 60-M .....MEAT PEN**

**Meat pens shall consist of three rabbits, all of the same breed and variety. Age limit: 10 weeks. 3.5–5.5 lbs.**

If the pen is from a Breed having a broken color variety, the entire pen must be of the same color variety. A meat pen does not necessarily have to come from the same litter.
