#### 4H CLOTHING RULES

1. Open to all members in clothing projects but the exhibitor must be enrolled in the specific clothing project in which she/he exhibits.
2. Articles must be made since last year's Fair.
3. Each article must have an attached CARE LABEL, written on a piece of paper or card giving care instructions. No care instructions will result in the ribbon value being lowered.
4. May enter unlimited number of items per CLASS if not repetitive and different construction technique used.
5. Fashion Revue enters DEPARTMENT 73, DIVISION 73G

6. 4-H'ers may be involved in one interview judging session in each division.

#### DIVISION 69-A..... ADVENTURES IN FAMILY LIVING

Exhibitors must be enrolled in the 4-H Beginning Project. Exhibitors may enter any article made in this project in the following divisions.

#### DIVISION 69-B..... SINGLE GARMENT

Single item of clothing such as a skirt, shorts, slacks, blouse, shirt, jumper.

#### CLASS 01 – SIMPLE

#### PREMIUM POINTS

#### CLASS 02 – DIFFICULT

#### PREMIUM POINTS

**DIVISION 69-C ..... TWO PIECE OUTFIT**

Two or more garments to be worn together. Examples: skirt and blouse, pants and shirt, jumper and blouse

**CLASS 01 – SIMPLE**

**PREMIUM POINTS**

**CLASS 02 – DIFFICULT**

**PREMIUM POINTS**

**DIVISION 69-D ..... DRESS**

Dress, 1 or 2 piece coordinated fabric, suitable for day-time wear.

**CLASS 01 – SIMPLE**

**CLASS 02 – DIFFICULT**

**PREMIUM POINTS**

**DIVISION 69-E ..... COAT OR SUIT**

Suits of matching or coordinated fabrics or coat.

**PREMIUM POINTS**

**CLASS 01 – COAT OR SUIT**

**DIVISION 69-F ..... EVENING WEAR**

Clothing you would wear to a formal or semi-formal occasion. Includes evening gowns, tuxedos, and prom-type dresses. (cont. next column)

**CLASS 01 – EVENING WEAR**

**DIVISION 69-G ..... NIGHTWEAR**

Pajamas, nightgowns, robes.

**CLASS 01 – SIMPLE**

**CLASS 01 – SMALL SEWN ITEMS**

Clothing accessories or miscellaneous sewn non-clothing  
(kites, small flags, book bags, back-packs, set of 4 placemats  
or napkins).

**CLASS 02 – HOUSEHOLD ITEMS**

Sewing aids, tablecloth, table runner

**CLASS 03 – NON-SEWN ITEM**

Fleece scarves, fleece tied blankets, quilts

**CLASS 04 – GROUP ENTRY**

Clothing and Textiles project completed by 2 or more  
members *(must be entered under club name)*.

**PREMIUM POINTS**

**Blue** ..... 50

**Red** ..... 35

**White** ..... 25

**CLASS 05 – SMALL QUILTED OR PATCHWORK**

Small quilted or Patchwork Items or other small sewn items  
(under 16 square feet).

**PREMIUM POINTS**

**Blue** ..... 20

**Red** ..... 16

**White** ..... 12

**CLASS 06 – LARGE QUILTED OR PATCHWORK**

Quilted or Patchwork items over 16 square feet.

**PREMIUM POINTS**

**Blue** ..... 45

**Red** ..... 35

**White** ..... 25
