4H NEEDLEWORK RULES

1. The exhibitor must be enrolled in the project in which they enter.
2. Each exhibit must have a 3”x 5” card attached stating: Fiber content of thread or yarn and care label.
3. You may have more than one entry in each class but each entry must be different in design, different stitch.

DIVISION 70-A ANY ARTICLE MADE IN BASIC KNITTING

CLASS 01 – SIMPLE ITEMS

Slippers, bags, hats, scarves, potholders, etc.

PREMIUM POINTS

Blue 20
Red 16
White 12

CLASS 02 – DIFFICULT ITEMS

Sweater, afghans, slippers, large quilts, etc.

PREMIUM POINTS

Blue 45
Red 35

White 25

CLASS 03 – NOTEBOOK

Notebook with samples of stitches: garter, stockinet, ribbing, increase, decrease

PREMIUM POINTS

Blue 15
Red 11
White 8

CLASS 04 – NOTEBOOK

Notebook with samples of stitches: buttonhole, seed, cable, yarn over, seam joining, decrease, increase

DIVISION 70-B ANY ARTICLE MADE IN BASIC CROCHET

CLASS 01 – SIMPLE ITEMS

Bags, scarves, potholders, hats, etc.

PREMIUM POINTS

Sweaters, afghans, slippers, large quilt, etc.
