ENTRY AND EXHIBITS

- Entry form deadline: Third Friday in August by 5pm

- Exhibits accepted in 4-H Building Tuesday prior to Fair, 7:30am-11:30am. **After judged and displayed no exhibit can be moved to another location without Superintendent prior approval.**

EDUCATIONAL EXHIBIT RULES

1. Display or game may show any topic of an educational nature.
2. The size may range from small poster to booth.
3. The display may include sound, motion, mobile and 3-D, etc.
4. Exhibitors name, age group (Jr., Int., Sr.), and Kittitas County must be on back of poster.
5. Posters must be readable from 10 feet away (minimum letter size 1/2" high or a 48 pt. computer font), refer to the educational display guidelines available from the Extension Office for other design considerations.
6. All exhibits will be displayed as space allows, in appropriate area or barn
7. Exhibits not checked in by 11:30 am Tuesday will not be eligible for premiums or ribbons.
8. **Blue Ribbon winners wishing to exhibit at the State 4-H Fair must notify the Superintendent and submit State Entry Form by 6:00 pm Sunday. 4-H entries only**
9. One exhibitor will receive premiums for a group entry.

10. Exhibitors may only enter one entry per class/project.

Displays can be club or team entry, (1 display per club or team). Barn displays must be in place by Wednesday 8:00 pm.
