4H CREATIVE KIDS RULES

1. All participants must be properly enrolled 4-H members.
2. Creative Kids Projects are open to all 4-H members, regardless of 4-H project enrollment. Including Clover Buds.
3. No more than ONE (1) entry allowed per 4-H member in each Division.
4. Judging will take place prior to the fair and entries will be on display throughout the fair.
5. Entries will be released on Monday, September 5 (6-8 pm) or forwarded to the State 4-H Fair if qualified (1 per Division).
6. All remaining general rules for the Kittitas County Fair apply to all Creative Kids Projects.
7. **There will be no premium money for Creative Kids Exhibits.**
8. Rosettes will be awarded in each age group of each Division.

DIVISION 72-A CREATIVE ART "Nature Craft"

You must use natural items found in nature to make your creation. The creation should be usable and/or decorative. A 3" x 5" card must accompany the entry describing how the item was made and its use. Maximum size of the entry is 18" x 18" x 18". Items may be made from a pattern or may be an original design. While other decorative items may be used in the creation, it must be primarily made from natural items.

DIVISION 72-B CREATIVE RECYCLING "Recycled Styrofoam "

You must use Styrofoam (cups, plates, trays, etc.) as the primary basis for your creation. The creation should be either usable or decorative. A 3" x 5" card must accompany the entry describing how the item was made and its use. Maximum size of the entry is 18" x 18" x 18". Items may be made from a pattern or may be an original design. All items are to be constructed by the member.

DIVISION 72-C CREATIVE CULINARY "Cookies "

All entries are to be made from scratch. Items that require refrigeration will not be allowed. All entries must be baked. Entries may be any type of shaped cookie (dropped, shaped, refrigerated, rolled) and other types of cookies. Bar cookies are not considered "shaped". Items containing raw eggs will not be allowed. All entries must include the recipe used in preparing the item. An entry will consist of 4 cookies. Bring your entry on a sturdy disposable plate and sealed in a plastic bag. *Alcoholic items may not be used in the preparation of the entry.*

DIVISION 72-DCREATIVE POETRY

“ Summer Fun ”

Entries must be original work completed within the past year. Each entry is limited to one 8 1/2” x 11” page. Printing must be 12 point or larger (easily read font) or hand printed. Illustrations are permitted, but must be contained within the one page. Entries may be metered, free verse, haiku or any other style of poetry.

DIVISION 72-E CREATIVE PHOTO

“ Agriculture and Farming ”

Photos must be either 5”x7” or 8”x10”. All photos must be firmly mounted on matte board. Minimum matte margin is 1” on all sides. Maximum matte margin is 2” on all sides. All entries must be printed on photographic paper. Photos MUST be representative of Agriculture and Farming. People, equipment, crops, animals or anything else that is representative of agriculture. Photo Label (C0890) should be completed and attached to the entry. Framed entries and non-mounted entries will not be accepted. Photos must have been taken by the 4-H member. All photos must be captioned.

DIVISION 72-FCREATIVE GARDENING

“Garden Themed Gift Basket”

Select a small basket (12’x12” max) and fill it with tools, seeds, and supplies for your garden. All items in the basket must be usable. It is preferable that at least one item in the basket be handmade. Total cost of all items in the basket shall not exceed \$10. A 3” x 5” card must accompany the entry describing how the item was made and its use.
