No stock draw, all stock will be chute run by day-sheet order; Open catch pen; Ground Rules posted Friday night prior to rodeo. Turnouts prior to 8/1will be refunded 50%; Turnouts after 8/1 will not be refunded except a refund of 50% will be granted with a written vet/med out. Management reserves the right to make changes and limit or refuse entries. Entries will be taken on a first come, first serve basis. \*Contestants may enter up in breakaway (Peewee boys/girls) or tie-down (Junior boys) roping for go-around awards only; points will NOT count for all-around.
