Qualifications

- Must be enrolled in an accredited 2 or 4-year academic institution or trade school.
- Must be a current Kootenai or Shoshone County resident.
- Preference will be given to youth who have actively assisted in some capacity at the North Idaho State Fair and Gem State Stampede (exhibited/performed, trash pick-up, food booth worker, ticket taker, etc.).

Scholarship

Value of the scholarship is dependent on the donor and ranges from \$500 to \$1500.

Scholarship payments will be made directly to the institution, payable in one installment, once the recipient provides written documentation confirming their enrollment, a student account number and the mailing address of the bursar/finance office at said academic institution. For some reason, if the student is not enrolled at that time, they have to used within 12 months from the date the scholarship is awarded.

Photo Submission

All applications are asked to submit a 5x7 headshot photo with their application. Photos will not be used in the selection process. Photos will be used for promotional posters. Inclusion is considered authorization to use.

Letters of Recommendation

Secure two letters of recommendation, prior to Friday, March 1st, 2024. One must be from an educator, the other from someone familiar with your career goals. Reference letters are to be submitted directly in an electronic PDF format to foundation@northidahostatefair.com (indicate "NIF&RF Scholarship - Applicant Name" in the subject line).

Submission Procedures

Once the required sections of the application have been completed, save this document in a PDF format and submit it electronically as an email attachment to foundation@northidahostatefair.com.
