

The Columbia River Circuit, Gem State Stampede, Pendleton Round-up and sponsoring rodeo committees are dedicated to promoting the sport of rodeo in the Pacific Northwest. Ultimately, through these efforts we will increase the number and quality of rough stock competitors and give local youth an opportunity at an affordable price.
