Refundable Grounds Clean Up Policy

Each vehicle hauling on to the fairgrounds will be charged a \$10.00 cash clean-up grounds fee per horse.

This fee is paid at the gate upon arrival and a receipt will be issued at that time. When your trailer area has been inspected and found to be free of debris and manure, your receipt will grant you a refund of these fees.

DO NOT PAY THIS FEE WITH YOUR SHOW FEES ON YOUR ENTRY FORM. Thank you.

<u>Championships</u> – In order to enter a championship class, you must have shown in a class of the same division to qualify.

Gate Passes (limit 3 per family)...... \$15.00

*Note about Stabling – Stabling is done at the discretion of the horse show management. Every effort will be made to accommodate exhibitor's requests.

ENTRY FORMS – Pre-Entry: All entry forms must be signed by the owner and/or trainer (as agent) if applicable and stall and entry fees must accompany the entry form. Pre-Entry acceptable method(s) of payment is a check or money order made out to the Lake County Fair. If you prefer, a <u>signed</u>, blank check may accompany your preentries and constitutes payment. <u>All tabs must be settled by Sunday at the end of the afternoon session</u>.

Post-Entry: Entries may be made at the show at no additional charge. **However, stall requests and payment must be done with an entry form by the deadline.** For proper entry into the computer, please enter at least one class. You are not committed to that class and can make changes once you arrive on the grounds. We are not able to accept phone orders for stabling.

PLEASE NOTE: This show is computerized, and due to the large volume of entries, office staff will welcome postentries up to **ONE HOUR** before the session starts. The office will then close for that hour to prepare for the session. Once the session starts, the office will reopen, and, if possible, the staff will make every effort to include new entries for the current session that are made at least three classes ahead. Coggins – As we are subject to surprise inspections, we request that all out-of-state exhibitors have their Coggins verification forms with them while at the show.

Major Change to Camping by Horse Barns with Electric – Please read!

No road parking around the fairgrounds will be allowed for campers and horse trailers waiting to get into the fairgrounds by order of the Crown Point Police Department. Therefore, the Fair Board is instituting a new policy for horse department exhibitors wanting to camp with electric facilities by the horse barns.

Reserved camping spots will now be assigned only to exhibitors showing horses by the horse barns. If you had a camping spot with electric last year, please confirm you are coming this year and you will be assigned a time to arrive.

If you did not have a spot last year, contact Greg Pater at: horsebarncamping@lake-county-fair.com **on or by June 1**st.

Pay for the number of days you will be staying once you arrive. Once your camper leaves your spot, that spot will be resold. You cannot pull your camper out for any reason and return to the same spot later. If you need to pull your camper out for a few days and want to return, you will be assigned a new spot. You cannot sell, lease or giveaway your spot to anyone else.

Costs: \$35.00 per night up to 30-amp electric service \$25.00 per night – no electric or water

Spaces are limited to 12' width only. Any added space used for canopies, etc. will be charged for as an additional full space.

ABSOLUTELY NO TENTS ARE ALLOWED TO CAMP HERE.

Tent camping is allowed only in the designated tent camping area on the fairgrounds.

We will make every attempt to accommodate your request but please note that there is a limited number of camping spots with electric, and we may not be able to honor all requests. We hope these changes will eliminate the past wait times to get into a camping spot and provide everyone with an easier and faster entry and exit of the horse barns camping area.

Golf Carts

No golf cars or motorized vehicles of any kind are allowed on the fairgrounds except for vendors, concessionaires, police, fair officials and service oriented (medical) vehicles. Superintendents may only use the vehicle on the day(s) of their own show. All persons must register with the Concessions Office, show proof of liability insurance for the vehicle, abide by the rules received, AND DISPLAY A PERMIT STICKER ON THE VEHICLE WHERE IT IS CLEARLY VISIBLE.

ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ARE PROHIBITED ON THE FAIRGROUNDS.

Rules and Regulations

The Lake County Fair will take every precaution to properly protect exhibits and/or animals. However, we will not be liable for the safety of exhibits, animals, exhibitors, employees, or families. Nor will we be liable for losses or damages sustained due to vandalism, theft, weather, fire, accidents, or any other cause. Exhibitors wishing to insure themselves, their belongings or their livestock may do so at their own expense. Each exhibitor will be responsible for any injury that may be occasioned to any person or any animal or damage to any property while on the grounds by a horse owned or exhibited by him and shall indemnify the management against all legally established claims or damages of any kind or nature that may grow out of any injury occasioned by any horse owned or exhibited by him. Presentation of an entry blank shall be deemed acceptance of these rules.

Exhibitors are hereby notified that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to judges and/or officials on the part of the exhibitor shall forfeit his entry, stall fees, and prize money. The Horse Show Committee shall have the power to bar an offender from further competition and have him/her and his entire exhibit removed from the grounds. The Horse Show shall not be held liable for damages of any kind as a result of such action, and this shall be accepted as a condition of entry. Horses must be kept under control and, if not, at the discretion of the judge, they may not be allowed to compete. Owner will forfeit entry fees in this case.

NOTICE: You cannot enter the fairgrounds with horses or campers until 12:00 p.m. on August 5, 2021. All stalls and campers must be out by 8:00 a.m. on Monday, August 9, 2021.

ARENA SCHOOLING HOURS

Thursday: 3:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. Friday: 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

If there is enough time, we will open the arena in between sessions for working your horses. The ring being open in between sessions is NOT guaranteed.

PASSES

Passes are <u>not</u> mailed. The horse show office at the horse arena will open at NOON on August 1st and remain open until 8 p.m. that evening so that passes can be picked up by exhibitors before there is a charge at the gate. If you cannot get to the office prior to 8 p.m., you will be charged at the gate when you arrive on August 2nd. If charged, ask for admission and parking tickets from gate personnel. You can receive a refund with these tickets at the Treasurer's Office. If you have any questions or concerns, please call Matthew at 219-669-3444.

PARKING

All trailers must be in the designated areas. This effort is being instituted to make more parking readily available for fairgoers and exhibitors alike.

GENERAL CLASS SPECIFICATIONS

Any class designated with A/HA is for purebred Arabians (A) or Half-Arabians (HA). If no such designation or specific breed is listed with the class name, then the class is open and any breed may enter utilizing the proper equipment for that class (i.e. Western equipment or English equipment).

Warm Up Arena

The warm-up ring attached to the main arena is for use by ABC exhibitors only ONE class ahead of their entered class. All other warm-up must be done be behind the barns. Thank you.
