

GENERAL RULES

No alcohol, illegal substances or weapons allowed on the fairgrounds. No animals are allowed on the fairgrounds unless they are exhibiting or are in use as a service animal. Exhibiting animals are only allowed in the specific show area.

MOTORIZED VEHICLES ON THE GROUNDS. Only authorized vehicles are allowed, or ones that have paid the \$25.00 sticker fee can be used on the fairgrounds. Some areas are totally restricted from these. A map can be obtained when the vehicle is registered. Handicapped vehicles are exempt from registration fee.

CAMPING ON GROUNDS - Enter Gate #6 on Greenwood Avenue. NO HORSE TRAILERS ARE ADMITTED AFTER 9:00 PM NIGHTLY. Gate 6 closes at midnight, no entry allowed after that time. Uniformed security is on duty. MAJOR CHANGE TO CAMPING BY HORSE BARNS WITH ELECTRIC - Refer to our website for more information: lake-county-fair.com, click on Exhibitors Menu, Exhibitors, Camping. Email: horsebarncamping@lake-county-fair.com after June 1st.

Daily Fees: \$25.00 without electric, \$35.00 with electric, at the horse barn. Tents are only allowed in the campground-west of the bridge.

No reservations, first come, first serve only.

Parking attendants will direct all campers and trailers.

Only exhibitors may camp at horse barn camping area during their show only.

No week long camping is available behind barns, only in the campground. Camper or trailer with only one car or truck attached is allowed.

Spaces are limited to 12' width only-any additional space used will be charged as another space and must be paid for as such.

The Lake County Fair will take every precaution to properly protect exhibits and/or animals. However, we will not be liable for the safety of exhibits, animals, exhibitors, employees, or families. Nor will we be liable for losses or damages sustained due to vandalism, theft, weather, fire, accidents, or any other cause. Exhibitors wishing to insure themselves, their belongings, or their livestock may do so at their own expense.

A \$10.00 ground fee per horse, with or without stalls, will be collected in cash at the gate, or you may write a separate check for this amount and send with your entry form. A receipt will be given. KEEP YOUR RECEIPT! NO REFUNDS WILL BE ISSUED WITHOUT THE ORIGINAL RECEIPT! When you are ready to leave the grounds contact Arena Office or "Designated Inspector" to have your trailer area inspected. If your area is clean & free of all manure, you will receive your cash refund. REMEMBER YOU MUST HAVE ORIGINAL RECEIPT, FOR REFUND.

RULES AND REGULATIONS DRAFT HORSES, FARM TEAMS, MULES AND PONIES/HAFLINGERS

- 1. Entries close July 25, 2022, OR WHEN THE BARN FILLS UP. Fees that must accompany entry form: \$15.00 exhibitor (one per entry), \$10.00 per head, \$10.00 per stall, \$5.00 office fee (one per entry).

 Additional \$15.00 helper's tickets may be purchased for people who will be going out of the gate and coming back in multiple times Wednesday and/or Thursday after 3 P.M. (free admission before 3 P.M. on those days) or Friday all day.
- 2. Exhibitors may arrive anytime after 12 Noon on Wednesday, August 10th and SHOULD BE IN PLACE BY 4 P.M.
 - IF SHOWING THAT NIGHT.
- 3. MULES AND FARM TEAMS working out of their trucks or trailers may come in Thursday **BEFORE 3:00 P.M.**
