

Guidelines for writing a bio:

Your bio should be brief and unique to you. There are no rules, only suggestions, so be creative.

Here are some ideas:

- Introduce yourself.
- Consider sharing what club you are in, how many years you have been in 4-H or FFA.
- Share a goal or the most important thing you learned in your project this year.
- Share some details about your animal. What breed is your animal? Does he/she have a name? Is your animal home raised from your family's herd? What other things might you want to tell a prospective buyer?
- Thank the prospective buyer for considering your animal and for supporting the 4-H and FFA.
