Merna Ann Hecht, poet, gardener, & editor of *Our Table of Memories: Food & Poetry of Spirit, Homeland and Tradition*

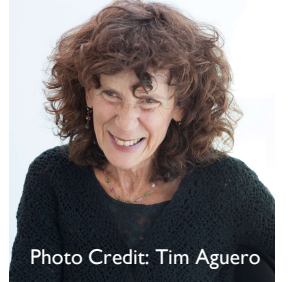
