

Market Animal Sale Committee Policies for the 2022 Latah County Fair.

1. All consignors must be enrolled in a Latah County 4-H club or be a member of an FFA chapter in Latah County. Only one market project may be sold by each consignor.
2. All large animals sold must have an initial weight and all animals must be carried as a project for the length of time listed for each animal in the 4-H and FFA project requirements to be considered complete.
3. The market animals accepted, and the order of the sale will be determined by the Latah Market Animal Sale (LMAS) Committee.
4. Market projects to be sold must be weighed the Wednesday of the County Fair on certified scales at the Fairgrounds.
  - Market Swine: 6:00 a.m. – 11:00 a.m.
  - Market Beef: 11:00 a.m. – 1:00 p.m.
  - Market Sheep/Goat: 1:00 p.m. – 2:00 p.m.
  - Small Animals- at the direction of the superintendent
  - No Late Weigh-Ins

All selling weights of livestock must meet the following restrictions to be sold through the 4-H and FFA Market Animal Sale. (Beef, sheep, swine, & goats over the listed maximum weight will sell at the maximum weight)

- Beef: 1050-1550 lbs.
  - Lambs: 110-150 lbs.
  - Goats: 70-120 lbs.
  - Swine: 230-295 lbs.
  - Rabbits: 3.5lbs. – 5.5 lbs. each; and under 10 weeks of age
  - Turkeys: at least 15 lbs. (hens), 20 lbs. (toms) and under 20 weeks of age
  - Chickens: Minimum of 5.5 lbs. each and under 12 weeks of age
5. All youth must complete a LMAS Consignment/COOL form by August 15th
  6. Animals entered in the sale must have been entered and judged for quality in the 4-H or FFA Division of the Latah County Fair.
  7. Animals awarded a white ribbon in the quality show will not be eligible for the sale.
  8. Market beef project animals must have Brand Inspection papers, Hauling Permits and Bill of Sale to present to the Superintendent prior to weigh-in.
  9. It is the responsibility of 4-H and FFA exhibitors to understand and abide by the floater animal policy and the sale procedure guidelines as found at <https://www.latahcountyfair.com/p/fair/sale>
  10. All Sheep/Goat Market Projects must have a scrapie tag.
