

Pomona Award Guidelines

Purpose: An incentive award to encourage members to continue their 4-H participation.

Eligibility and Requirements:

- The 4-H member must be a first, second, or third year member. There is no age limit.
- First and second year members must complete at least one project and place with a blue, red or white ribbon.
- Third year members must complete at least two projects and place with a blue, red or white ribbon.
- Members who qualify for a county award in a specific project may not receive a Pomona Award in that project.
- A member may receive only one Pomona Ribbon per year and it may represent one or more projects.
- A member may receive only one Pomona Ribbon during their membership in 4-H except in occasional situations where an incentive is warranted.
- An organizational or project leader must submit a written recommendation.

Selection:

Pomona award winners are selected by the Awards Committee. These selections are based on recommendations submitted by the organizational or project leader. Leaders need to be prudent with the number of members they recommend.

Submitting recommendations for 4-H members who have tried to do their very best and need an incentive will keep the Pomona a special award for those who receive it.

Sponsorship:

The Pomona Grange sponsors the Pomona Awards. A representative from the Grange will award them on Achievement Night.
