WHEREAS, NMSA 1978, Section 4-38-12 as amended, allows the County Commission to establish rules and regulations to govern the transaction of county business in these meetings.

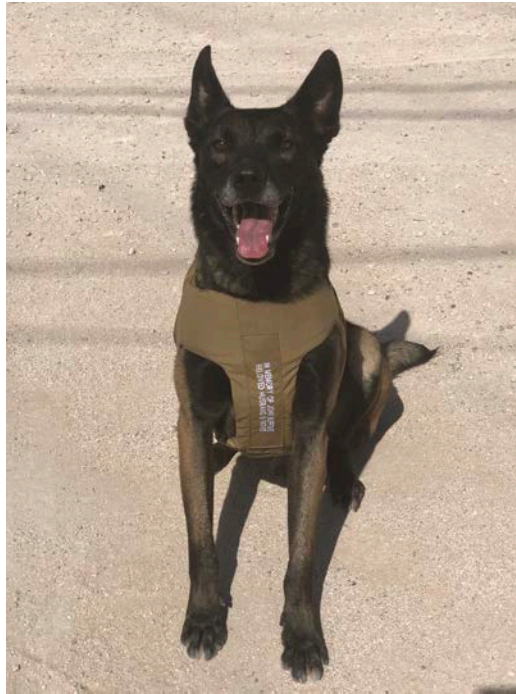

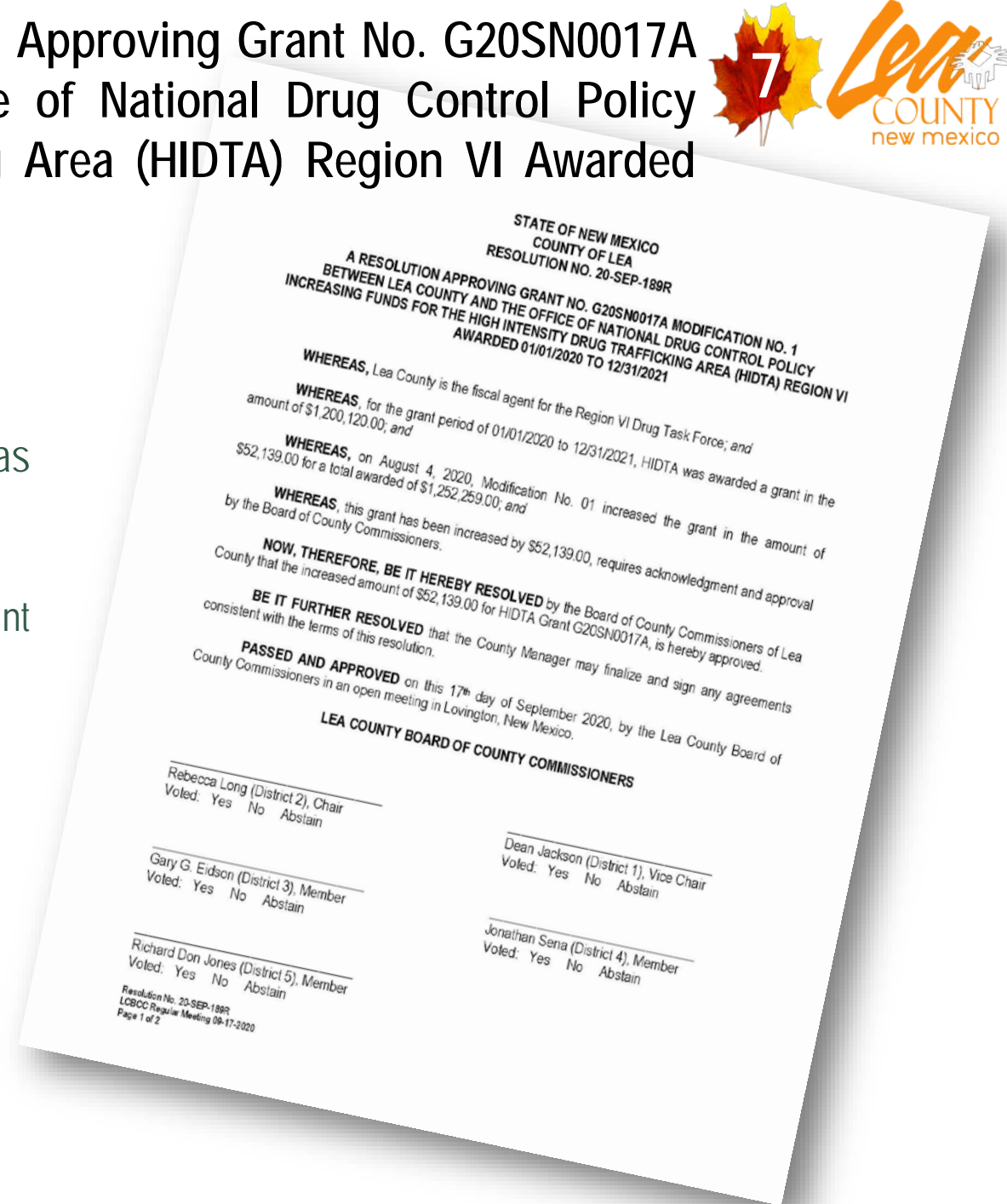

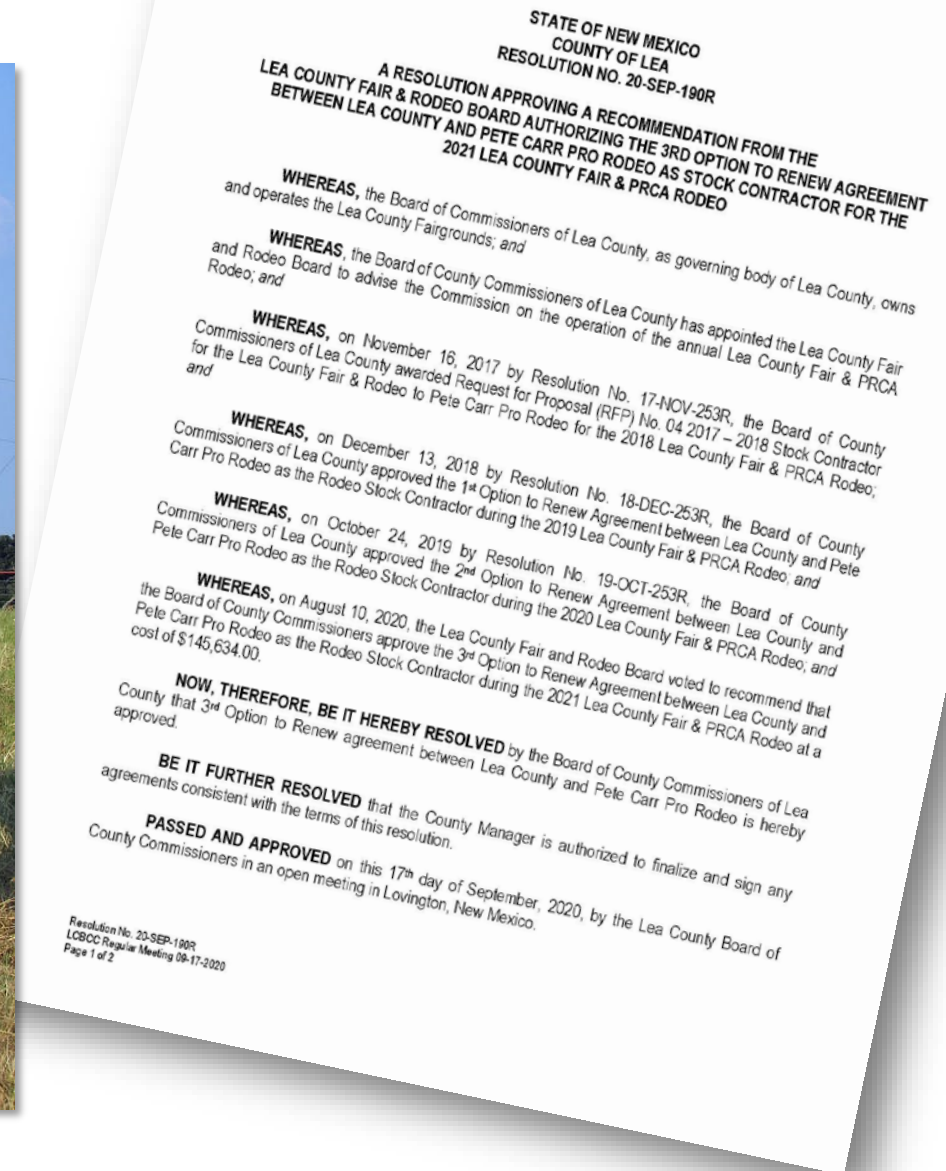
Lea County is the fiscal agent for the Region VI Drug Task Force.

The Federal Government has provided a total of \$150 billion to the Corona Virus Relief Fund to States, the District of Columbia, U.S. Territories, and Tribal governments.

Lea County was awarded a total of \$530,750 to fund our local initiative.

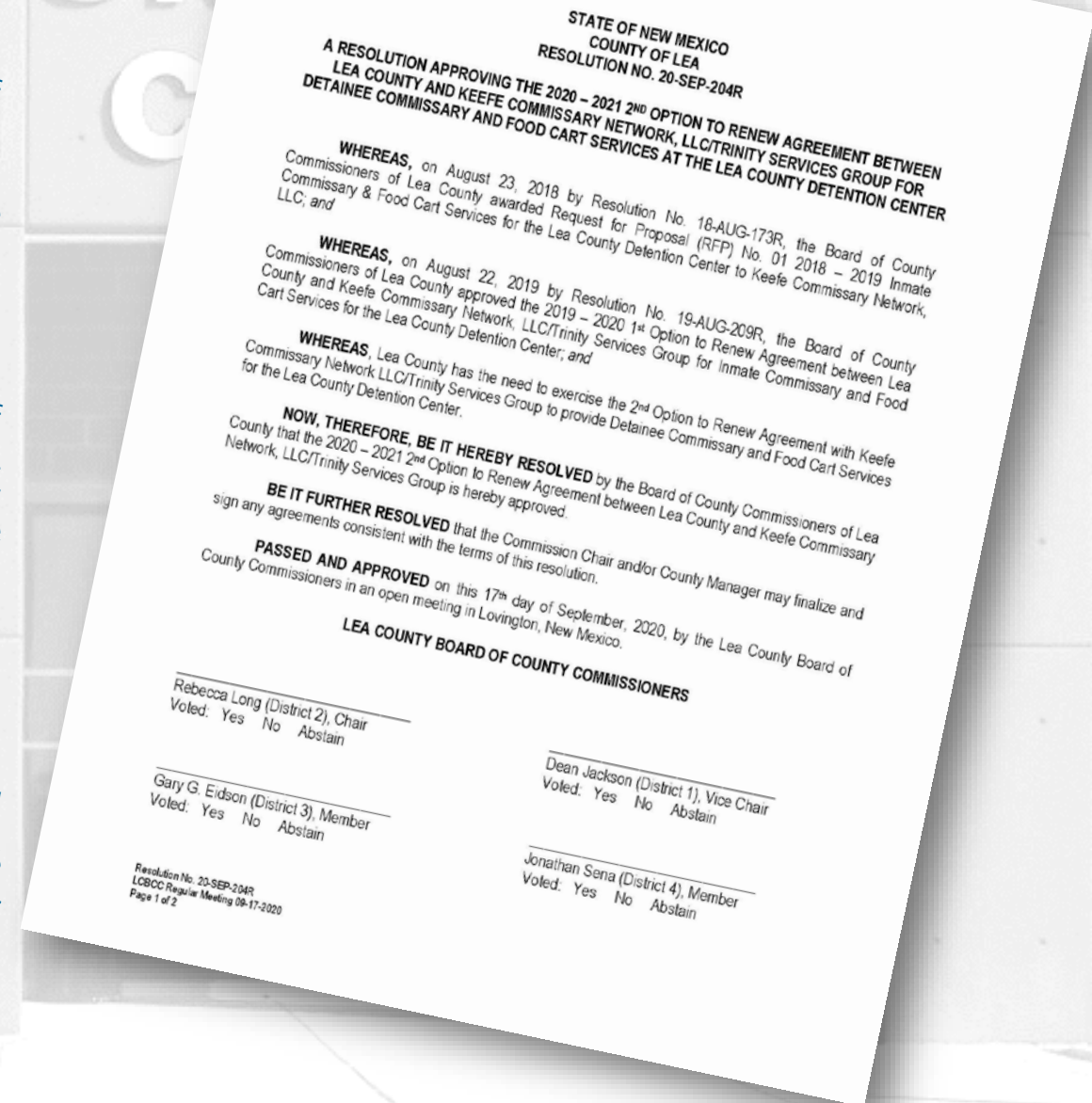

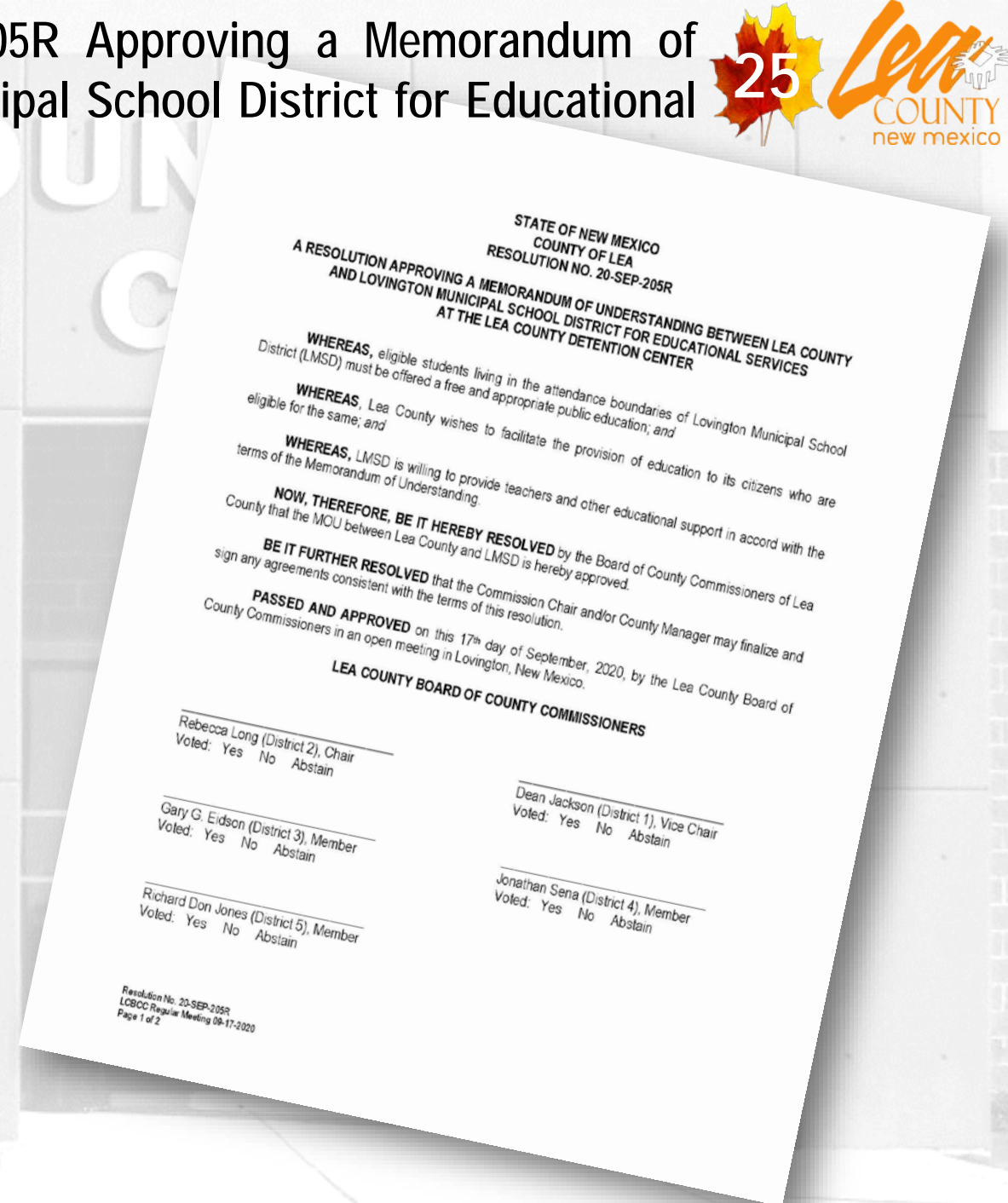

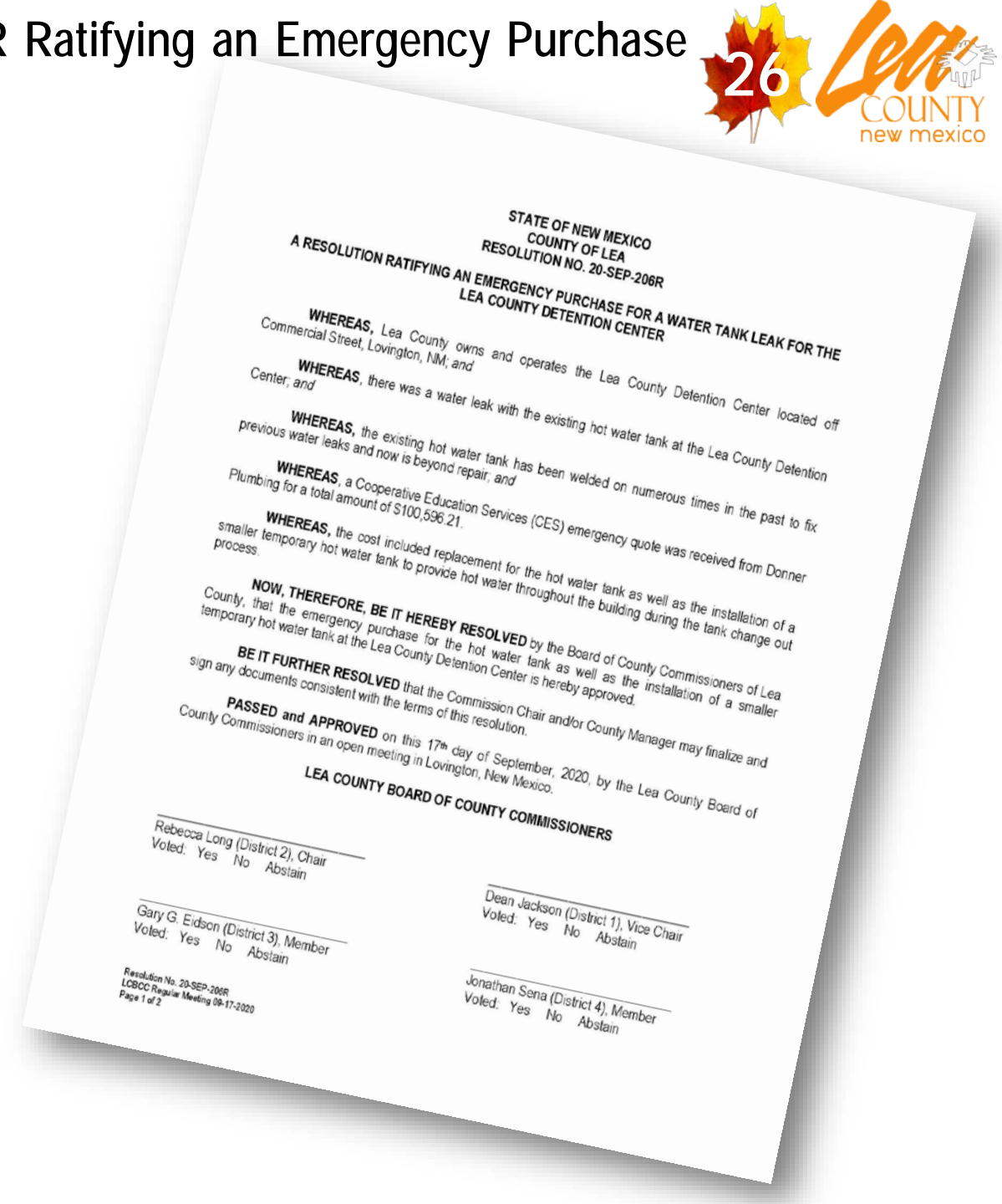
Eligible students living in the attendance boundaries of Lovington Municipal School District (LMSD) must be offered a free and appropriate public education.

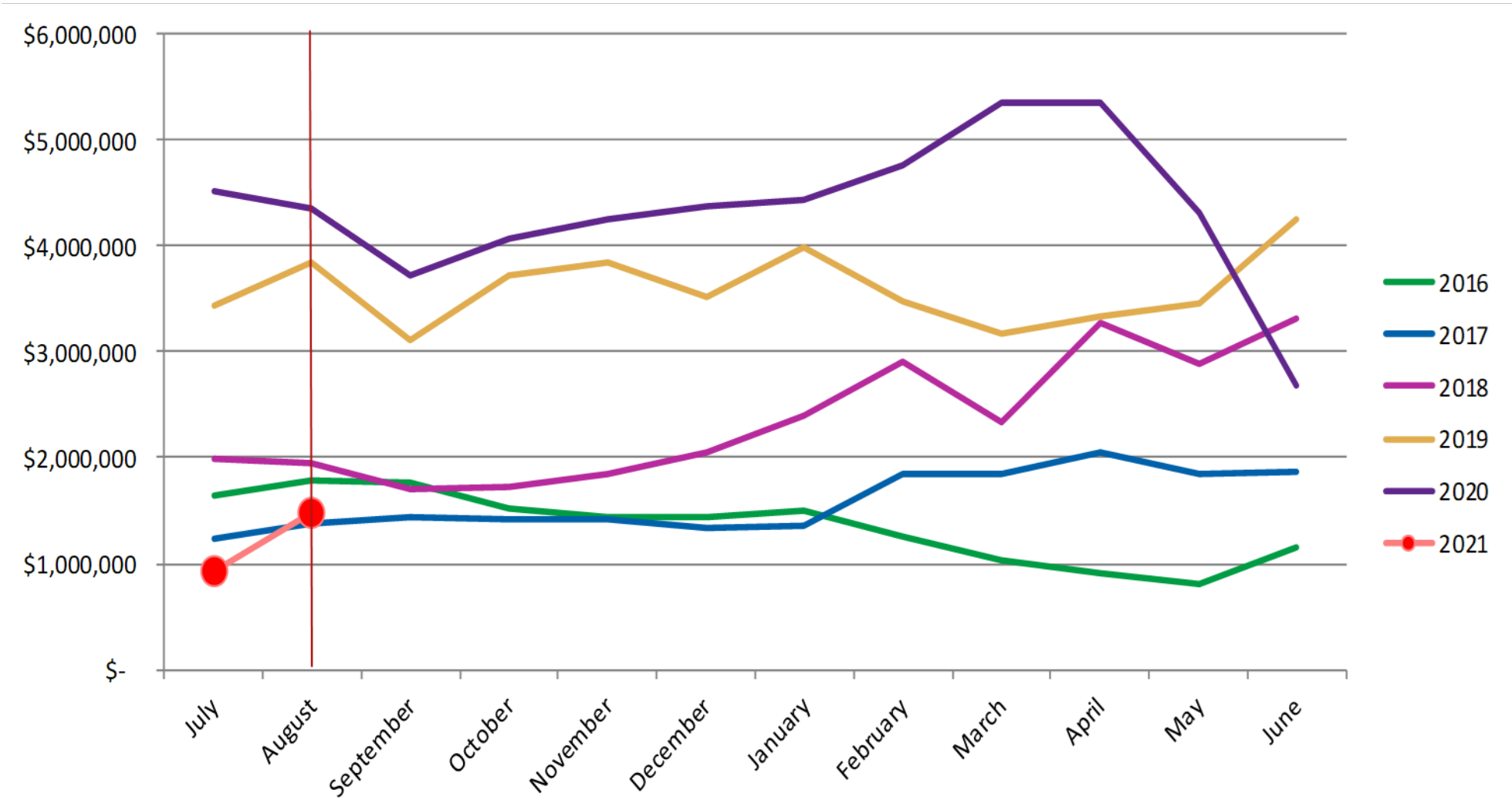

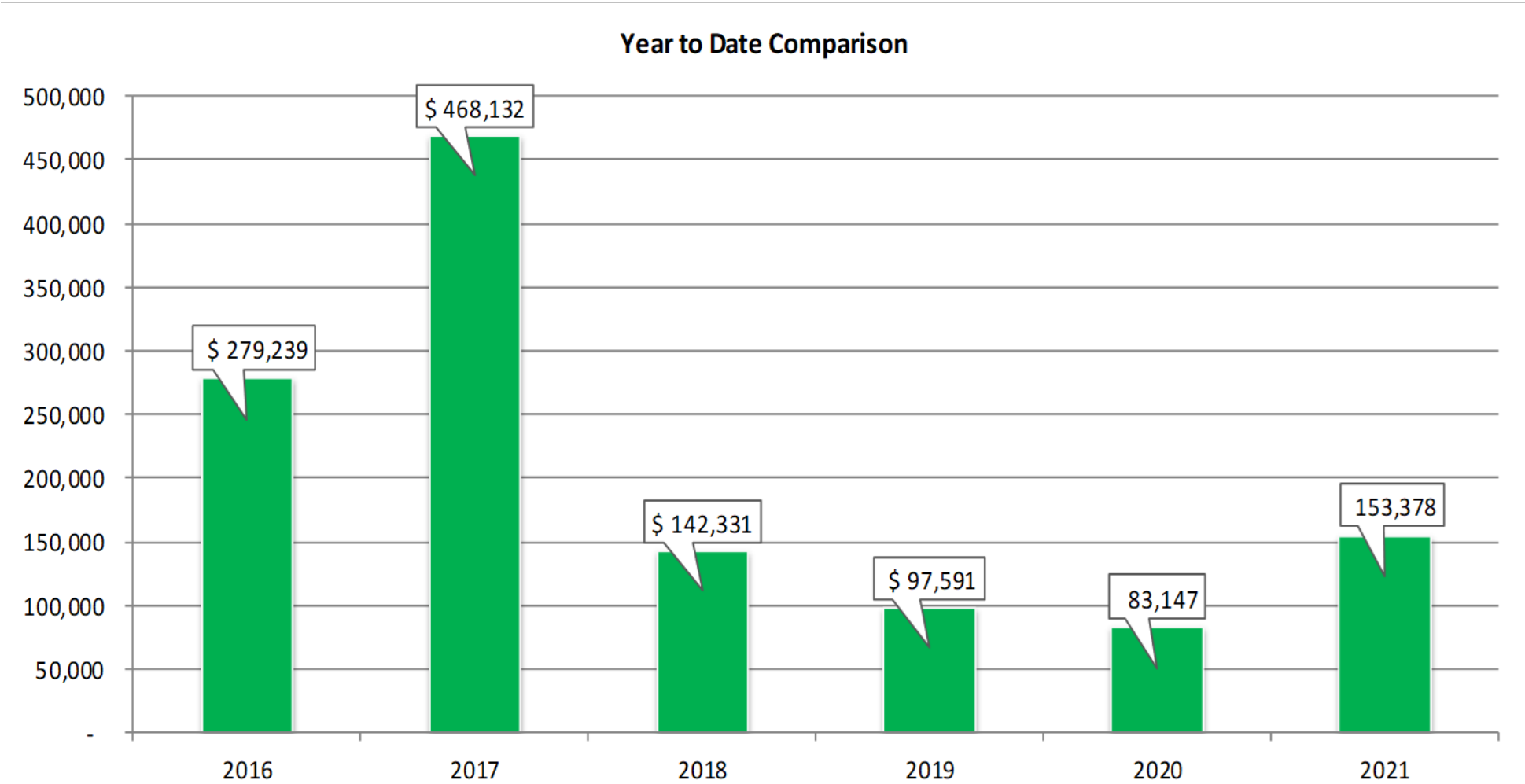
Oil & Gas Production Revenue

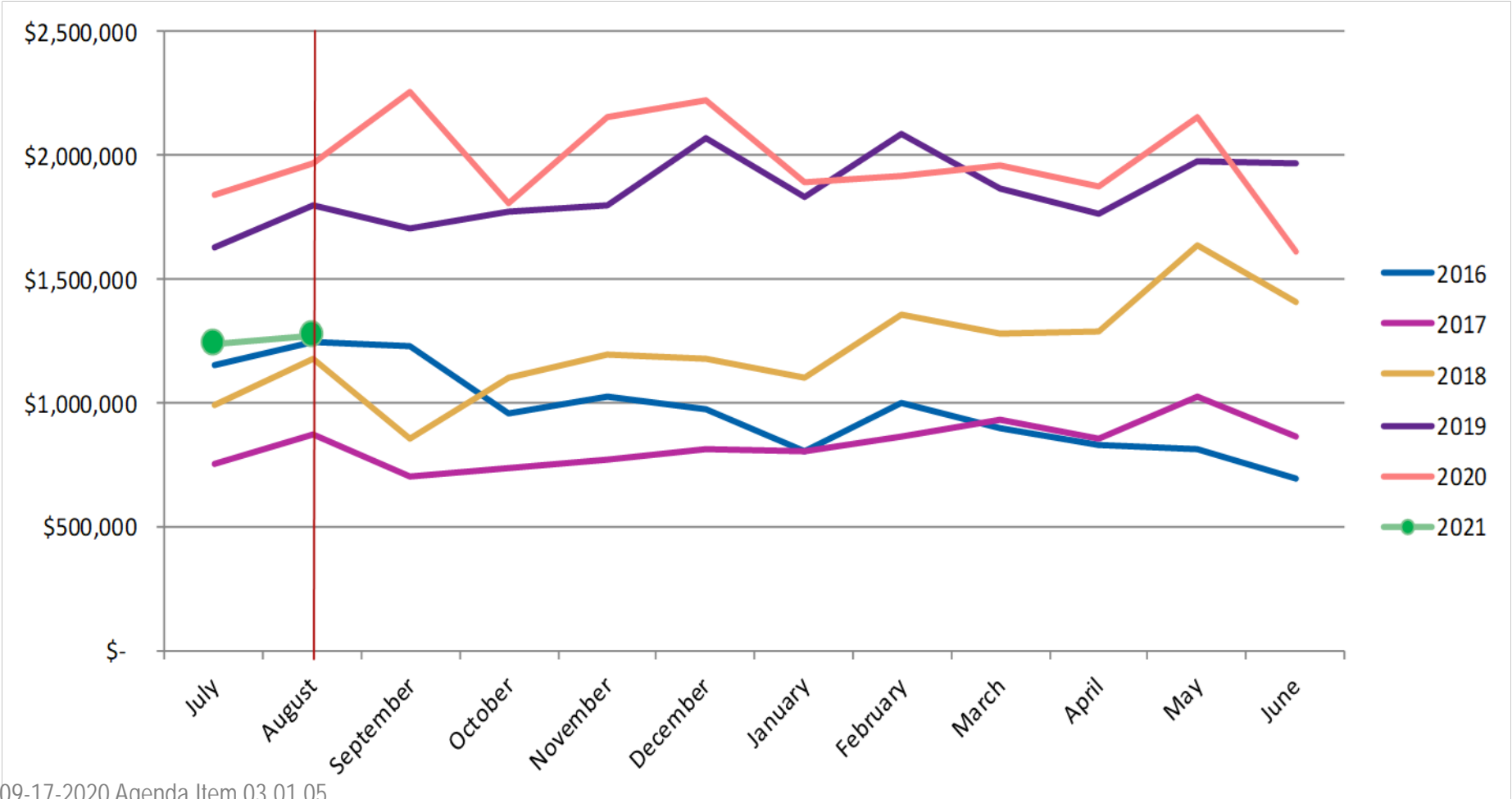


Property Tax Revenue

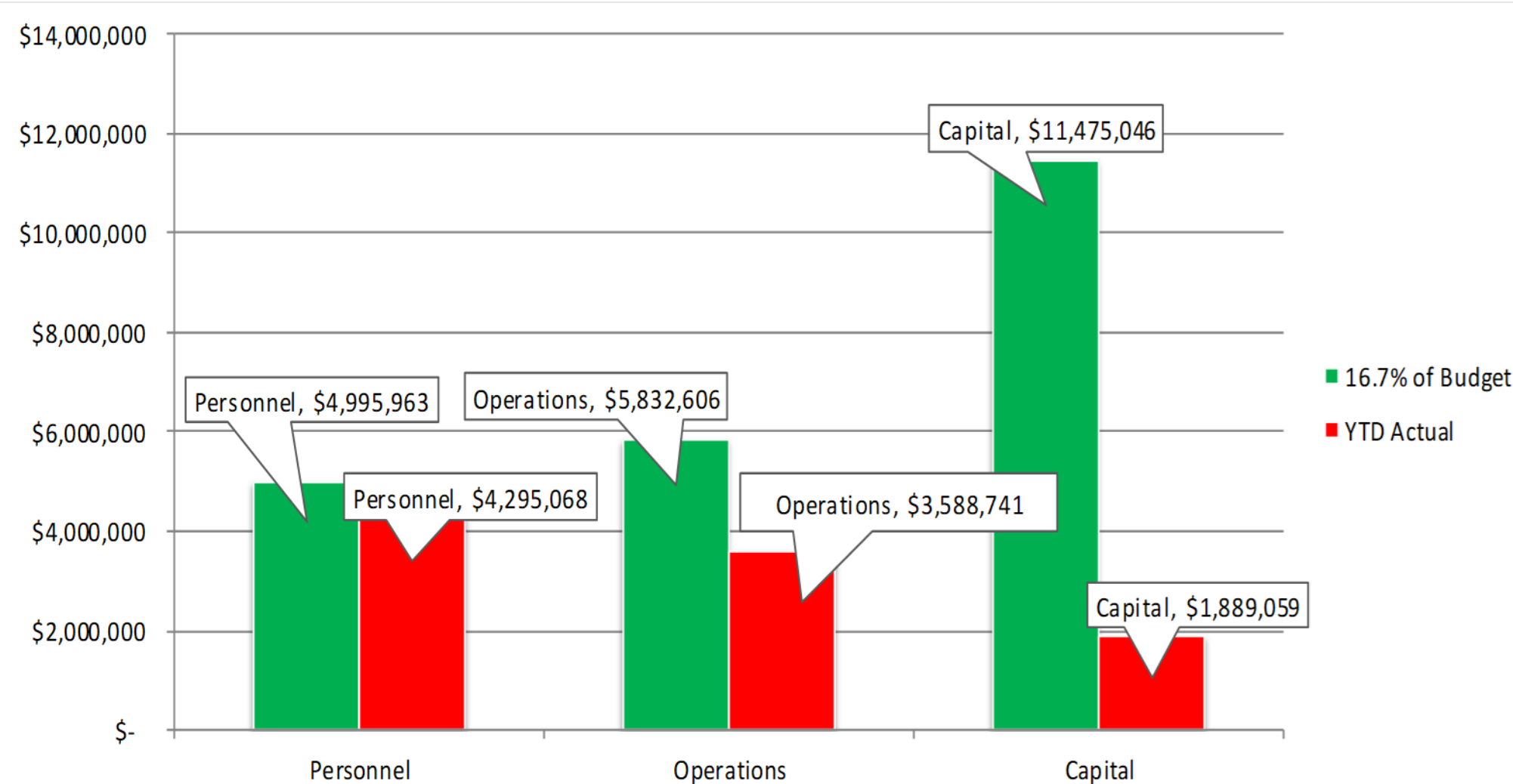
