

**Minutes of Meeting
Lea County Board of Commissioners
September 30, 2021**

Chair Long called the meeting to order at 9:03 a.m. in the Lea County Courthouse

Alan Pyle, Presenter for Water Fleet (Company) - Discussion of their intention to get a permit from the Environmental Department for the operation of portable water reclaiming and supply rigs on Construction Sites, for Temporary Housing and on Remote Work Locations.

Waldy Lopez, Co-Presenter– Spoke about how this has already been in use for over three years in Texas.

Chair Long questioned Mr. Pyle about the movement and numbers of these rigs.

Mr. Pyle replied to her stating they would move from site to site dependent upon need and he could see them operating about 50 units at 50 different locations at this time.

Commissioner Sims had a question about the cleanliness and TDS of the reclaimed water.

Mr. Pyle replied to Commissioner Sims saying TDS is low equivalent to that of purified bottled water. He added that the reuse standard would be determined by the Environmental Department but the water after processing was even better than the water brought in for use before reclaimed.

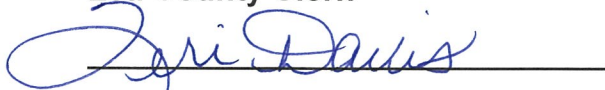
