

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN ENGINEERING STUDY ON THE HVAC SYSTEMS AT THE LEA COUNTY DETENTION CENTER

WHEREAS, the Lea County Facilities Department is responsible for maintaining certain county facilities and certain county space; and

WHEREAS, an engineering study is required for Honeywell to permit the project of replacing 37 RTU's at the Lea County Detention Center; and

WHEREAS, the project qualifies for funding under the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) as ventilation improvements in congregate living facilities; and

WHEREAS, the Lea County Board of County Commissioners approved a plan in Lea County Resolution No. 21-OCT-226R to allocate ARPA funding to improvements at the Lea County Detention Center.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Lea County that the engineering study of the HVAC at the Lea County Detention Center is hereby approved using ARPA funding.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Commission Chair and/or County Manager may finalize and sign any agreements consistent with the terms of this resolution.
