



The cost to retrofit the banquet hall lighting and lobby would be \$199,493.70. I would like to ask for a total of \$220,000.00 to be prepared for any		
possible unforeseen items that may be encountered with the retrofit. The addition funds would be approximately a 10.5% increase. The scope of work		
will also include the installation of a new Leviton Sapphire Technology dimming panel as well as new control stations in each room of the banquet hall. All the 10" can lights will be replaced with new recessed LED dimmable light fixture. They will also install a new selectable color cove lighting		
accent in each banquet hall section. All work performed by Lynco Electric would be through there CES contract.
