A RESOLUTION CONDITIONALLY ACCEPTING THE TRANSFER OF LAND FROM THE
CITY OF LOVINGTON

WHEREAS, the City of Lovington currently owns land on which it operates a waste collecting convenience center and houses its Road Department; *and*

WHEREAS, the City of Lovington has offered this land to Lea County; *and*

WHEREAS, Lea County plans to use the land for county operations including but not limited to road department activities, environmental department activities, limited recycling, and limited waste acceptance/collections, also known as a convenience center.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Lea County that it accept the transfer of land from the City of Lovington on the following conditions:

1. The City of Lovington will have a survey performed and perform all acts legally necessary to separate the land containing the two baseball fields from the land being transferred to Lea County, all at its own expense;
2. Lea County will have an environmental study showing that there are no environmental conditions that would cause Lea County not to wish to own the land being transferred, all at its own expense.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Commission Chair and/or County Manager may finalize and sign any agreements consistent with the terms of this resolution.
