WHEREAS the board, commission or other policy making body shall keep written minutes of all its meetings. The minutes shall include at a minimum the date, time and place of the meeting, the names of members in attendance and those absent, the substance of the proposals considered and a record of any decisions and votes taken that show how each member voted; and

Draft minutes shall be prepared within ten working days after the meeting and shall be approved, amended or disapproved at the next meeting where a quorum is present. Minutes shall not become official until approved by the policymaking body; and

**WHEREAS**, NMSA 1978, Section 4-38-12 as amended, allows the County Commission to establish rules and regulations to govern the transaction of county business in these meetings.





Lea County Commission 2021 Redistricting Plan

On November 21, 2019 by Resolution No. 19-NOV-285R, the Board of County Commissioners of Lea County approved the 1st Option to Renew Agreement between Lea County and Linda Brown and Associates, LLC., as the Entertainment Booking Agent for the Concert Series During the 2020 Lea County Fair and Rodeo.

On June 26, 2020 by Resolution No. 20-JUN-150R, the Board of County Commissioners of Lea County canceled the 2020 Lea County Fair and PRCA Rodeo due to New Mexico Department of Health – Public Health Orders related to COVID 19.

On July 23, 2020 by Resolution No. 20-JUL-155R, the Board of County Commissioners of Lea County approved the 2nd Option to Renew Agreement between Lea County and Linda Brown and Associates, LLC., as the Entertainment Booking Agent for the Concert Series During the 2021 Lea County Fair and Rodeo.




