


Consideration of Lea County Resolution 22-JAN-022R Approving Award of Bid No. 04 2021 – 2022 Knowles No. 2 Fire Station to Anissa Construction

Lea County has acquired land, designed and bid a 4 bay, 5,700 sf fire station meeting the requirements of a "main" station by the NM State Fire Marshal. On December 14, 2021, bids were opened. Lasco Construction and Anissa Construction submitted bids. Anissa Construction submitted to the lowest competitive bid for the project.

The scope of work for this project includes an approximate 5,759-sf building consisting of preengineered metal building construction. Exterior preengineered metal building roof and wall panel systems with split faced CMU veneer wainscot, interior and exterior. painting, floor finishes and ceiling. Electronics, doors and hardware. Mechanical, plumbing, and electrical systems. Exterior site improvements including grading and drainage, asphalt and concrete paving, site utilities.





Ms. Ferguson and Lea County,

Thank you for the opportunity to present this bid proposal.

In today's construction environment, Owner's have greater challenge to bring their projects in on budget and on schedule. Anissa Construction would like to be part of the solution. I understand there are real concerns about the availability of materials, skilled laborers, and positive communication with team members.

First, the delayed availability of materials is a new phenomenon. I have been able to avoid major delays with proactive strategies to order materials early to the construction process. Items with long lead times are identified on the submittal log and processed first. If a problem is identified, I can address the issue early with the team. I have already reached out to several metal building suppliers. At this time, metal buildings shop drawings are running 4-6 weeks. Fabrication time is estimated as 10-12 weeks. I have proposed a schedule to complete all the site and site utility work while the metal building is under fabricated.

Second, the availability of skilled laborer can affect both progress and quality of any project. I have been very fortunate to have a core crew that has been with me for 8 years. It is important to me and the crew that roots are set in the community. If the project is awarded to me, I would like to purchase property to live in during the project. With school aged children, I can effectively manage this project if my family is with me. By being part of the community, I would also like to employee local laborers and craftsman.

The third priority is to maintain constructive communication with all team members. Anissa Construction uses Procore Management system. This system allows for a transparent method to post daily photos, questions, schedules, and construction drawings. I work closely with the project team, including the Architect, with whom I already have a working relationship. A successful project is one in which the Owner receives a quality project in a timely manner.






Anissa Construction Company History





Project Summary

This project was a new construction for the City of Albuquerque. It involved working around the public, keeping their safety as a top priority. There is also a difference between working with the public and working with children. Extreme precautions must be taken when children are involved and our crew had no issue with that at all. It is about being more aware of your surroundings than one normally is which came naturally to our crew and subcontractors as the majority of them are parents themselves. However, there were ground rules that were always respected-for example there was never any communication allowed with the public or children, no swearing, and no smoking. Irrigation also needed to be coordinated thoroughly in order to keep water going to existing plants, which in some cases were very rare. This project's scope also contained some complex framing, which our crews excelled at.


