We have a staff of 12 employees; consisting of Assessor, Chief Deputy Assessor, Chief Appraiser, GIS Tech, 3 Appraisers, and 5 Deputy Assessors.

The Lea County Assessor is responsible for valuing all real and personal property for taxing authorities in the county, such as municipalities, school districts, and hospital districts. The Assessor manages a professional, courteous staff who provide the residents and business of Lea County with the following services;
Find, list, and value residential, commercial, vacant, and business personal property for ad valorem tax purposes.

Notify property owners of their assessed property value.
Prepare the county property real-property tax rolls for the Lea County Treasurer
Limitation on Increase in Value

Ensuring these things are accurate and timely results in fair and equitable assessment of real and personal property at a reasonable cost and a well-maintained, current tax base upon which local government can base tax levies.
